- There are 8-openings on the BPHSAA Board of Directors in August. Tammy, Dale, Dick, Ken and Neal all have terms expiring.
- TH is moving to Bend, Oregon by the end of May. She may be able to attend meetings via web or conference call.
 - JP offered to take procession of the alumni materials TH has been storing.
- Site Council Update by DB.
 - Small turnout at the last meeting.
 - It was decided to wait until the Fall to fill the open position on the council since no one knows who will still be at the school next year.
 - There is a desire to continue to have alumni serve on the council.
 - Mark Davalos, PPS Deputy Superintendent and supporter of CTE will be leaving the district to become the Superintendent of St. Helens School District.
 - Equal opportunity and sensitivity to minorities will be the mission for the 2011-12 school vear.
 - The district is moving towards an 8-period block schedule for all the high schools.
- Minutes for April approved.
- Account Balance: Approx. \$2135.56 and \$303.00 in Paypal.
 - \$460.00 was earned at Tech Show through donations, memberships and merchandise sales.
- Membership
 - Approximately 100
 - 13 at Tech Show and 29 from the postcard mailing.
- Tech Show Review
 - Action Item: JP and JS will enter the contact information from the sign-in sheets.
 - Next year BPHSAA will supply the beverages rather than have them catered. Cost difference is significant. Catered punch was nearly \$100 per night. For future shows, 5-gallon coolers of water and lemonade for each night.
 - Overall set-up worked well.

- Need more signs around the school to remind people to visit the alumni room.
- Slide show might have attracted more people if there had been music.
- Still would be nice to have some form of entertainment, either a band of vocal group.
- Only 1-person signed up to assist the BPHSAA in the future.
- Tech Show will be in February next year to better serve Freshman recruitment.

• Benson Centennial

- A subcommittee will need to be formed to address the future school centennial
- TH researched the Benson history. The Portland Trades School was started in 1908. It was renamed in 1915 after Simon Benson made his donation.
 - Since 2008 has already passed, it was suggested that the centennial celebration be during the 2015-2016 school year.
 - The freshman entering the school in fall 2012 will be the Centennial Graduating Class. It was suggested that marketing for the event should begin that year.

- CH says that '56 is planning something

Events

- Kenton Station saw about 15-people at the April meeting
- Other events in difference areas of Portland should be considered; southern part of the metro area.
- Picnic

 - Most of the details are made. TH will be sending out the duty sign-up at the end of July.
 - Nhi is in charge of organizing games.
- Mentoring would play a significant part in the school's student retention rate which is currently at 66%. The expected graduation rate is 77%. Effort should be made to find a contact at the school to help begin a program.

• New School Principal

- A new principal has not yet been chosen. The choice is likely to be made from candidates already in the district.
- An interview committee is in the processing of being formed, but they are having difficulty finding people to volunteer.
- They hope to have a choice made by the end of May.
