- Introductory Remarks by Dale Bajema
- Minutes from 12/10/08 meeting approved.
- Membership Count to-date by Tammy: 117 members; 5 retired teachers (3 paid); 4 from '08
- Treasury report by Paul B.
 - Account Balance: \$1571.10
 - An operating budget for 2009 needs to be completed.
 - Upcoming costs include the Tech Show and 02/11 Reception
 - Ken Bakke has volunteered to help Paul with the finances
- Scholarship Committee report by Bob Hyland and Don L.
 - Apparently there was some confusion with the combination of the donation cards and membership applications.
 - \$2900.00 was earned the campaign
 - 194 out of 1172 envelopes were returned which incurred a cost of \$81.58.
 - Bob will contact Mary Ganoe, the advisor of SkillsUSA to chase down incorrect addresses. He will make her an offer of \$0.50 or less per name
 - Motion is made and approved
 - Funds to pay SkillsUSA will come from the scholarship fund.
- Bulk Mail permit will cost \$180.00 per year and in order to use it we have to mail 200 items or more. Technically we cannot be using the PTSA's permit unless we have a letter from the PTSA giving us permission and the return address on items must have the school's address.
