BUSINESS

- In person people are in the Alumni room space!
- DM had to leave before the meeting, so update later.
 - o 1035 is the target student population for this fall.
 - They filled quota for Sophomore transfers.
 - Cutbacks Jefferson lost 9, Grant lost 6, Lincoln lost 6. We lost 0 on net basis – they rearranged the schedules of several teachers to fill needs. Principal Wilson seemed very optimistic yesterday.
- Guests
 - Heidi bringing music back to the school. Music club hasn't had great attendance but just trying to make space. Many students involved are also in Robotics and other clubs. Monday/Friday hasn't worked well. Working on a presentation for Tech Show in a visible space.
 - KBPS had purchased a baby grand years ago, but its location is unknown.
 - There are 2 pianos on campus. RJ offered a piano from his family; so far it's been refused. They believe the refusal is due to the belief there are enough there. Heidi is talking to the parents and students about what they need.
 - For pianos, there is also the concern about needed tuning/voicing.
 RJ noted that maybe Vancouver School for the Blind would do



- tuning at a discount. [post meeting: this school closed in 2017 due to lack of funding/students]
- Heidi's been teaching full time history and other subjects. She's also a professional musician. She can teach choir and orchestra but not band.
- Without a certified band teacher on site, access to PPS instruments has been blocked.
- If we can get a retired band teacher to volunteer some time one day a week? Maybe we could get some more momentum.
 - MB said Cynthia Plank who taught Band at Beaumont Middle School is retired or about to retire. MB will connect them via email.
- o KC pointed out that it comes down to denial of educational services and equity. We may need to have a conversation with the Directors on the PPS Board of Education, particularly targeting Directors with past or current stakes in BPHS and reminding them about promises for launching a performing arts program at BPHS.RJ: Since a music program was denied by the district for many years, despite the budget cuts we're in a better place now, where the district appears like it's favorable to this idea. We'll keep moving this forward.
- [After the meeting: BT noted he is donating a Korg TM-50 electronic tuner with pickup microphone to Heidi that will tune pianos and instruments.]
- Member Report (JP)
 - o Around 80 paid members.
 - By the end of the year, we should be over 100.
- Financial Report (BT)
 - \$3456.01 in savings, \$3656.93 in checking
 - Need to determine budget for Tech Show, depending on what we want to do.
- Prior Meeting Minutes Approval (MB)
 - Since minutes were first sent out after last meeting as 'Jan' instead of 'Feb', some people missed it. MB sent Draft 3 out today.
 Discussion ended with tabling approval of Feb minutes for next meeting.
- Tech Show
 - Taylor, the director, could come one of the nights and intro her movie.
 - Tom/Chet and Sig are the grandsons of Simon Benson. RJ: Sig has a more formal style of presentation; may not work with the format/time we have, but let's try and get both at the school, maybe a book signing?
 - KC: Amy will be addressing 7th graders in the auditorium, so maybe we screen the documentary and present in the community room? We have 40 minutes in the auditorium, just one of the 2 nights.

- RK: there had been 3 ideas for auditorium, to present and push people to alumni room.
 - Dan: state of the school (in lieu of Principal Wilson)
 - Taylor and the documentary
 - Chet/Sig presentation
- RK: is it possible to use space behind the auditorium? Then it would flow into 3rd floor alumni room. KC agreed. He'll inquire.
- Discussion: have the documentary running low volume in the alumni room (or directly outside), a few chairs, QR code to the upload.
- RJ will reach out to Chet and Sig to promote their books/history of Simon Benson. Probably in the space with the yearbooks near the Alumni Room.

• Tech Show Subcommittee:

- RK: Anyone attending, please come to April meeting at 4:30 to get details nailed down. She will look over the minutes and send out a note to subcommittee members.
- RJ: How can we get 'Alumni Room ->' posters around the school –
 JP: We also need some slides put into the rotation of whatever slide deck is being shown. KC will speak to DM about it.

- RK: Is there a question about sign-in per decade? Has it been fruitful? Yes, each board member will try and get volunteers to help.
- RE: standup of Simon Benson at the main entrance pointing them to the Alumni Room
- Signage at the old gym, where we used to be
- o KC will talk to DM to tell the guides to mention it as well.
- o MB: We need to utilize our volunteer base, too. Let's reach out and get some help manning cake and tables, then board can roam.
- If everyone can be there both nights, that is appreciated. It's going to be huge! And the more faces we have to represent the alumni association; the more personal connections we can make and get people interested in supporting the school.

 - Raise the idea that we would like an ad again this year. Probably \$200 to \$250 for the ad.


- RK moved that we allot up to \$250 for purchase of yearbook ad that RK will work with Greg on. GO seconded. Motion was approved.


