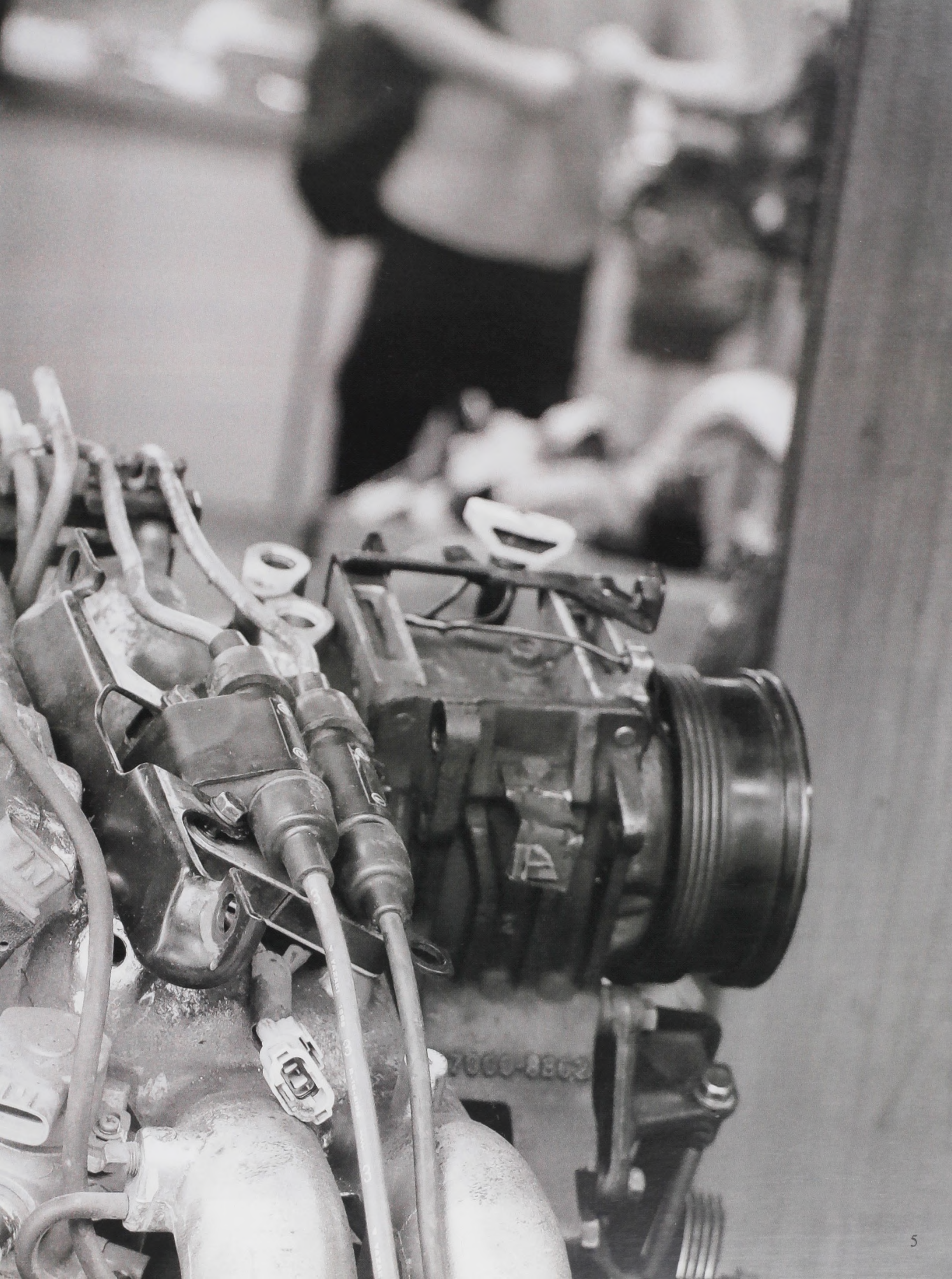

The Benson house

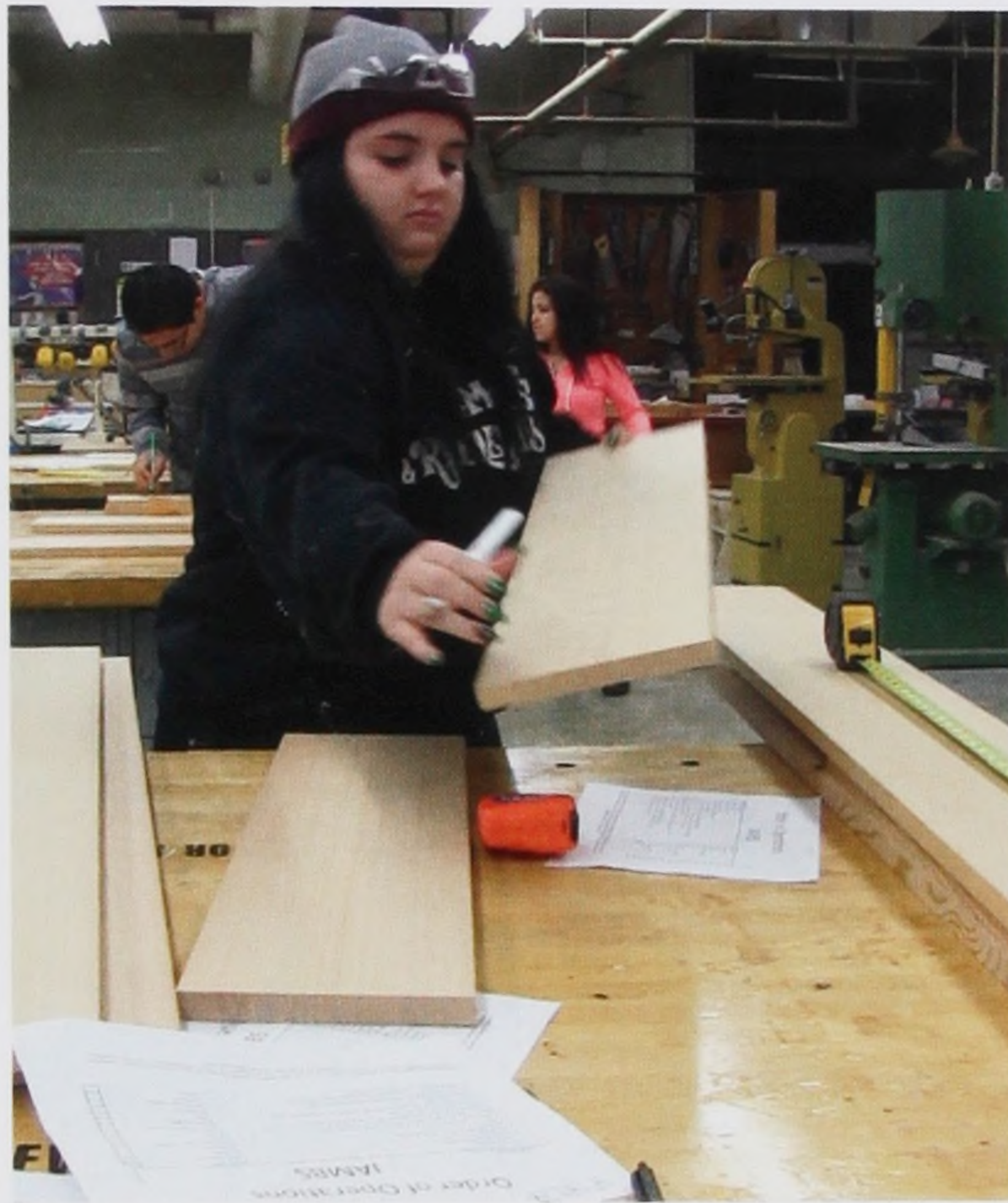

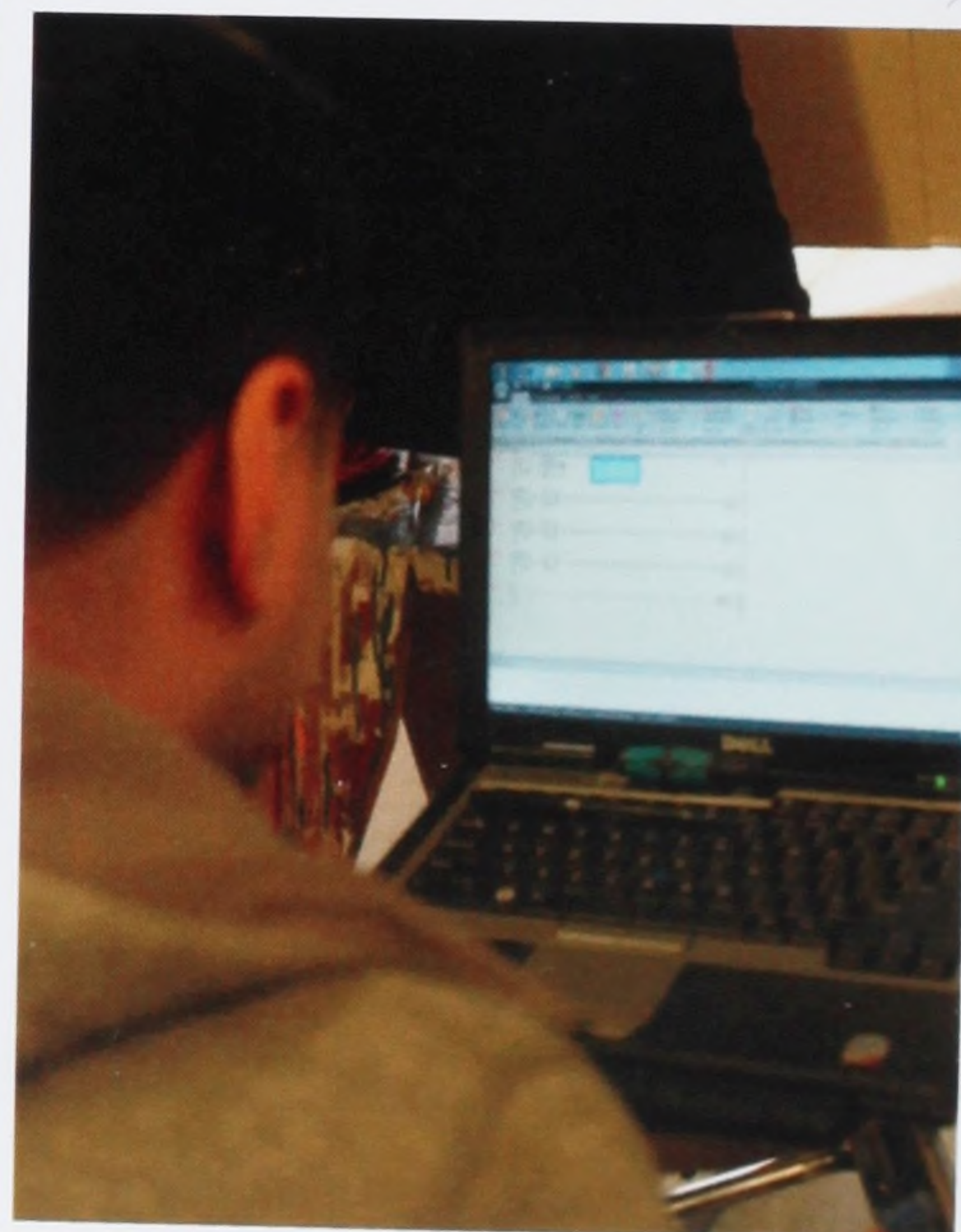
Training for the future

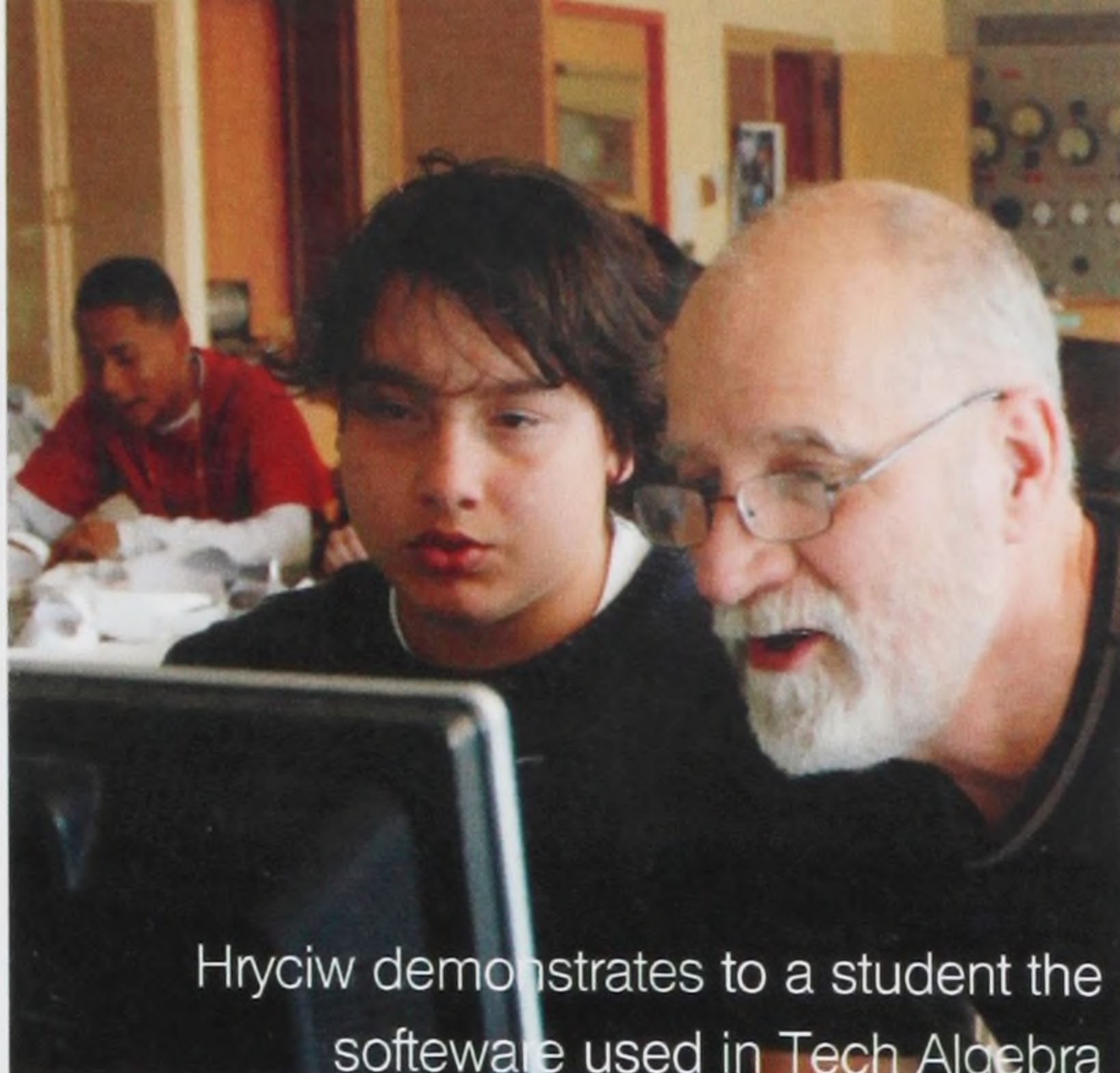
Tech Algebra and Tech Geometry: (See upper right hand corner)

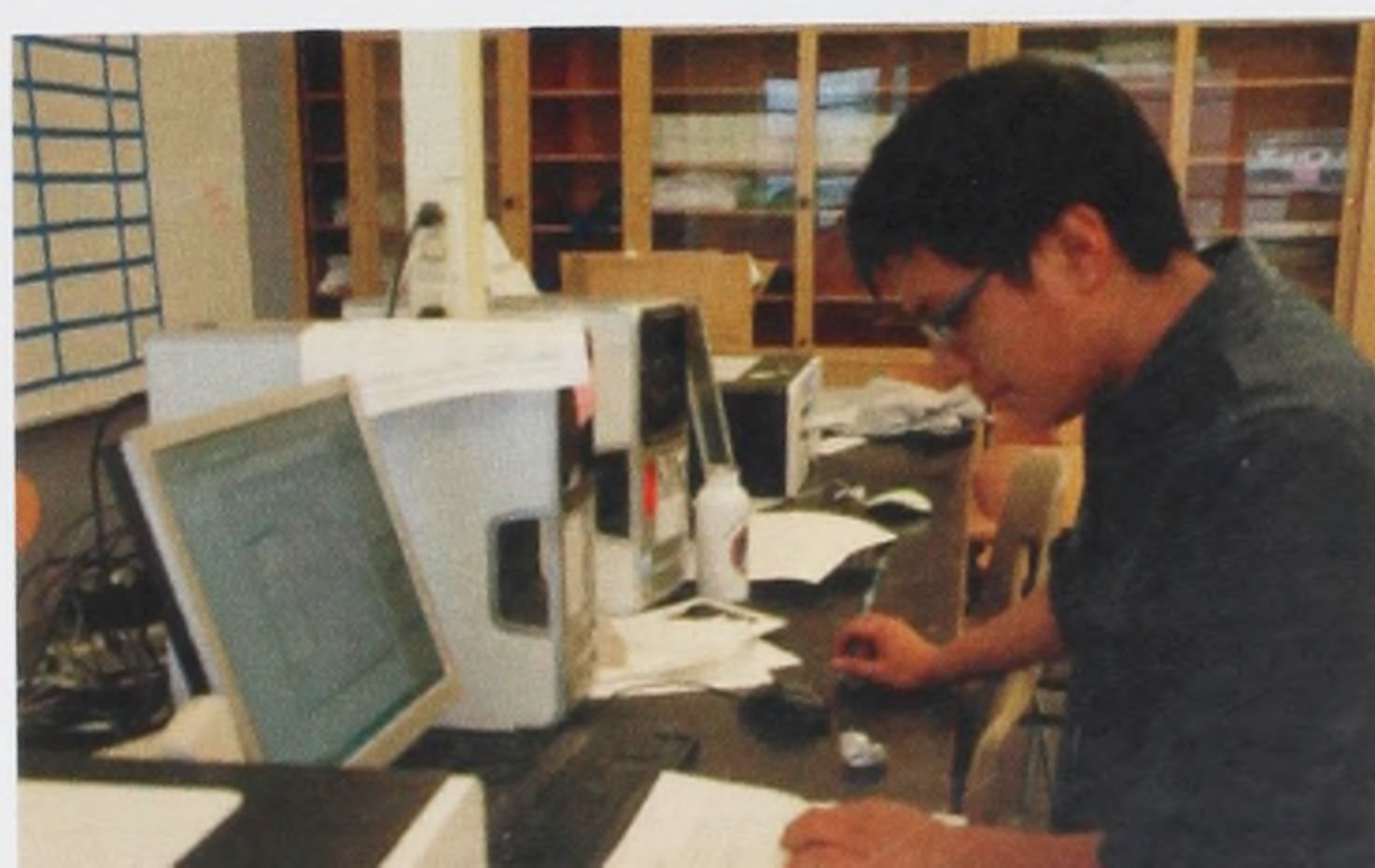
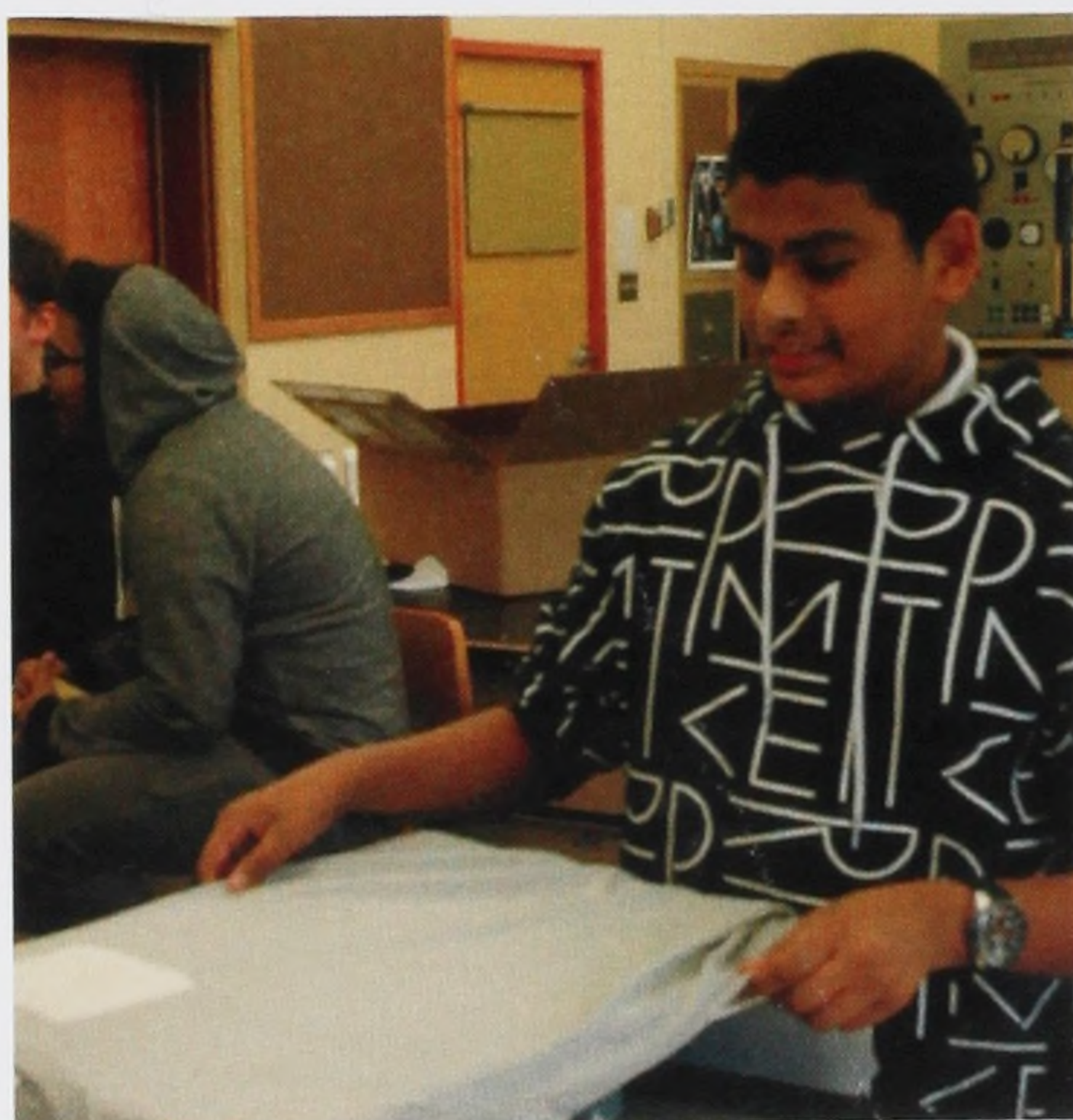
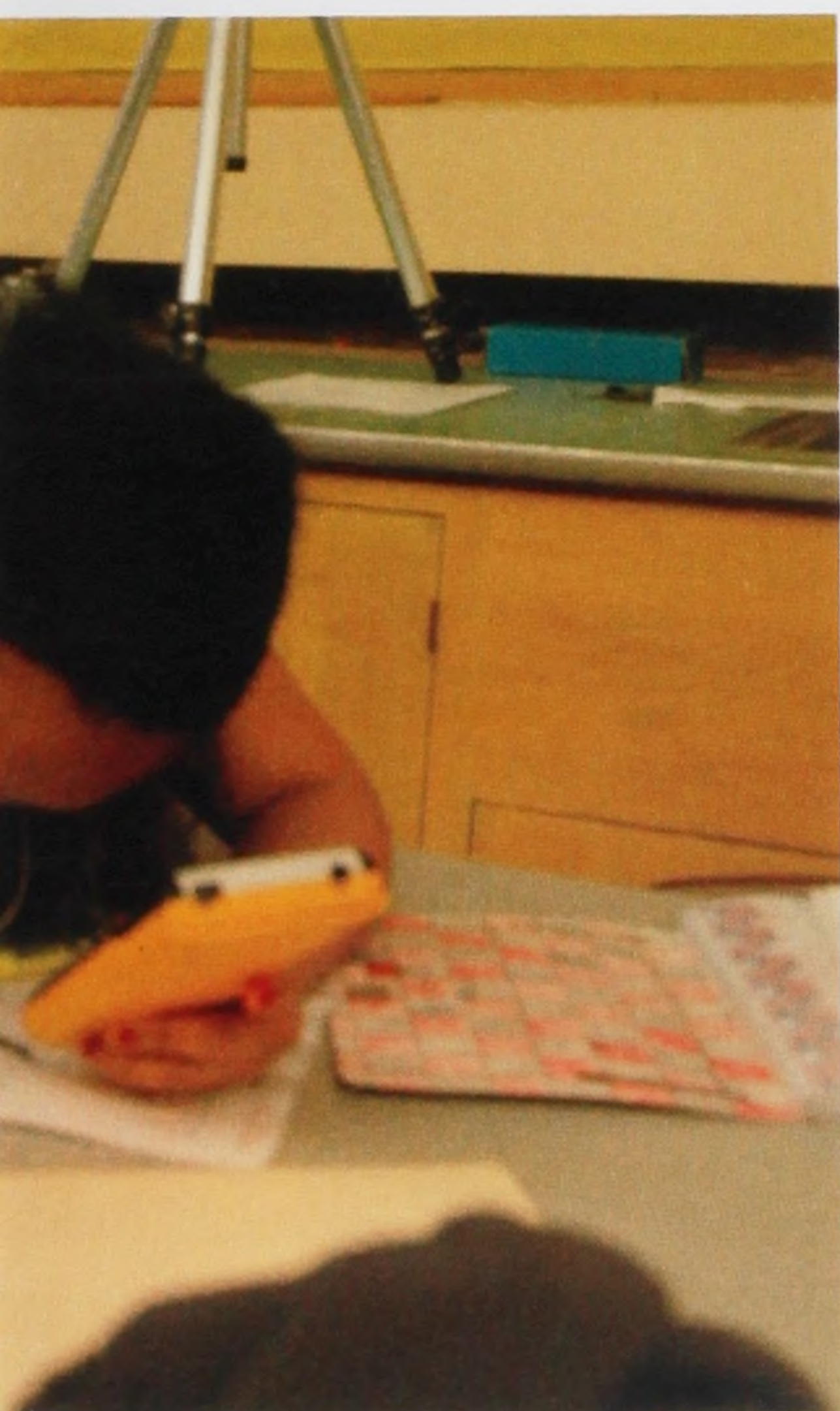
What is Tech Algebra all about?

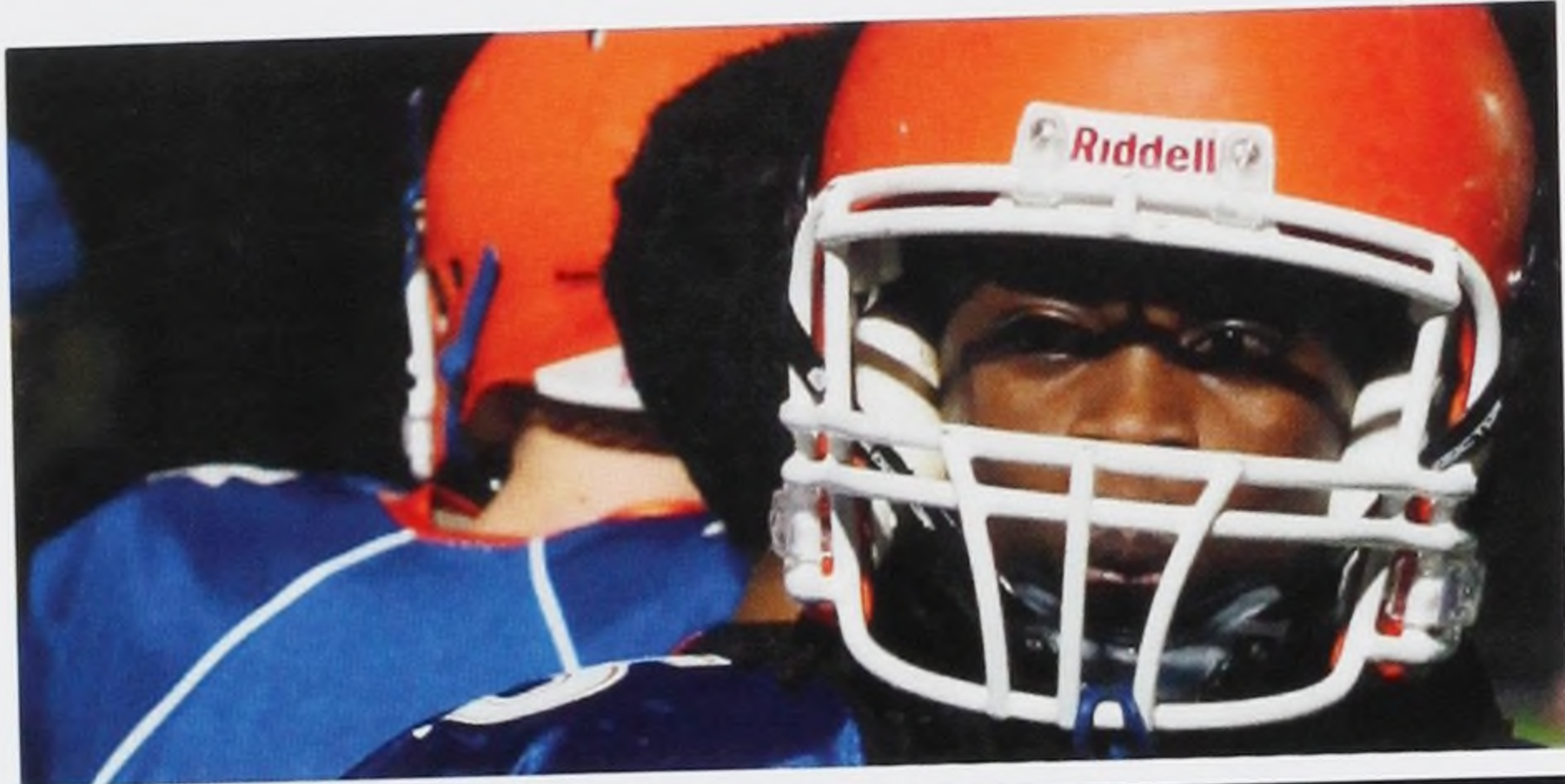

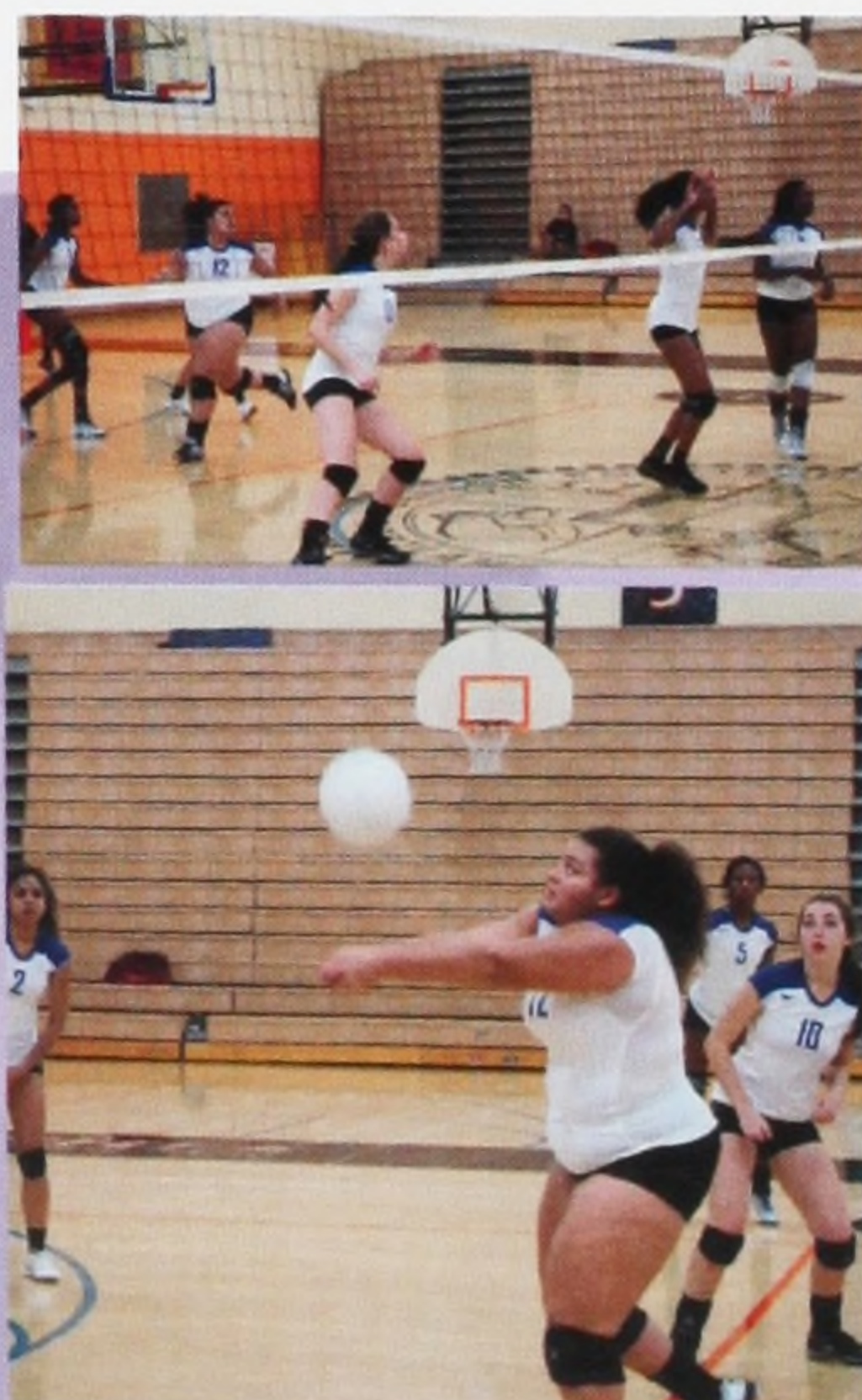
United in all forms, the volleyball teams have sweated and suffered through injuries, and set backs. But the important part is perseverance and dedication to their sport. You go girls!

Don't let your mind control what's inside of you

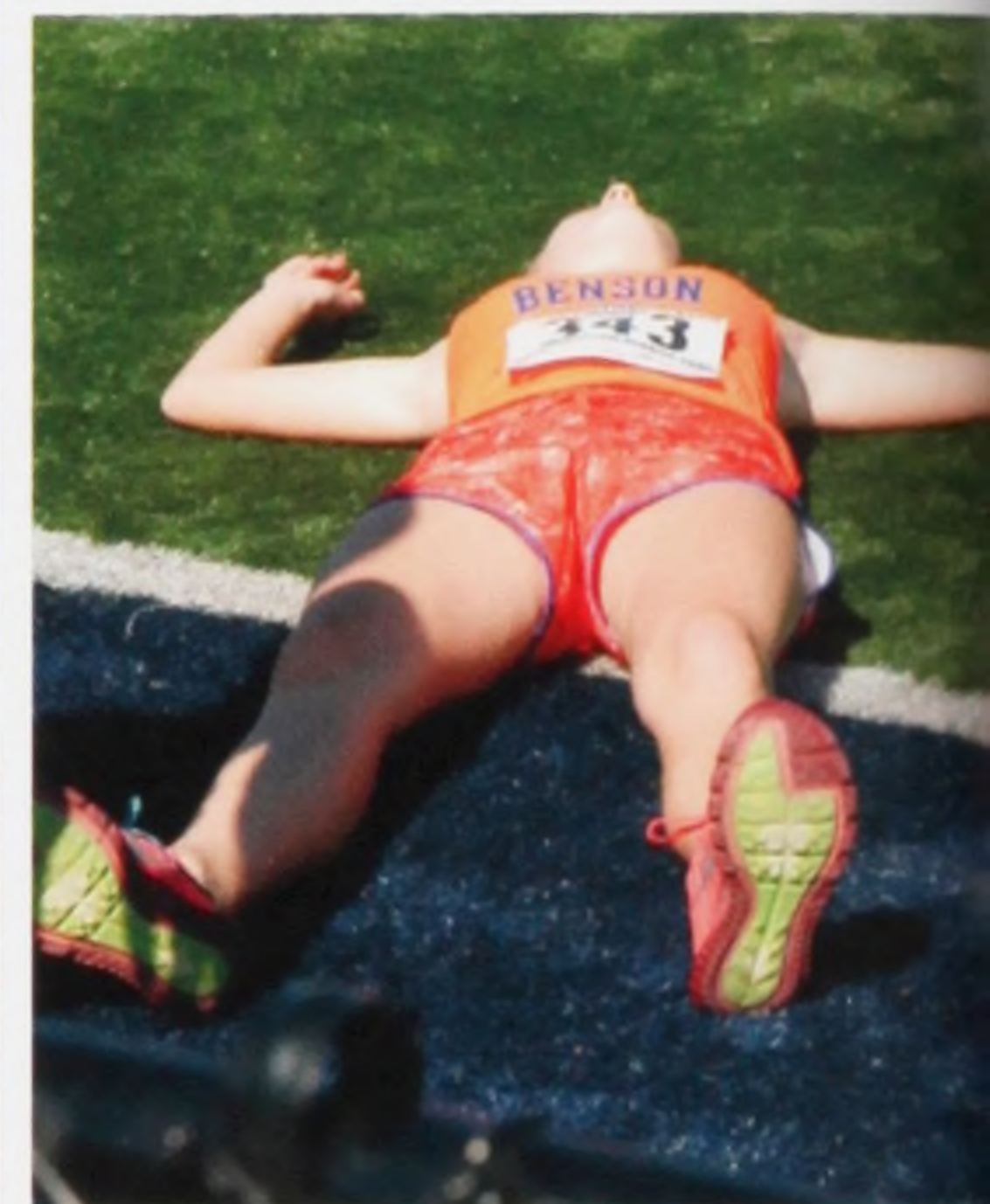
When will I be there...

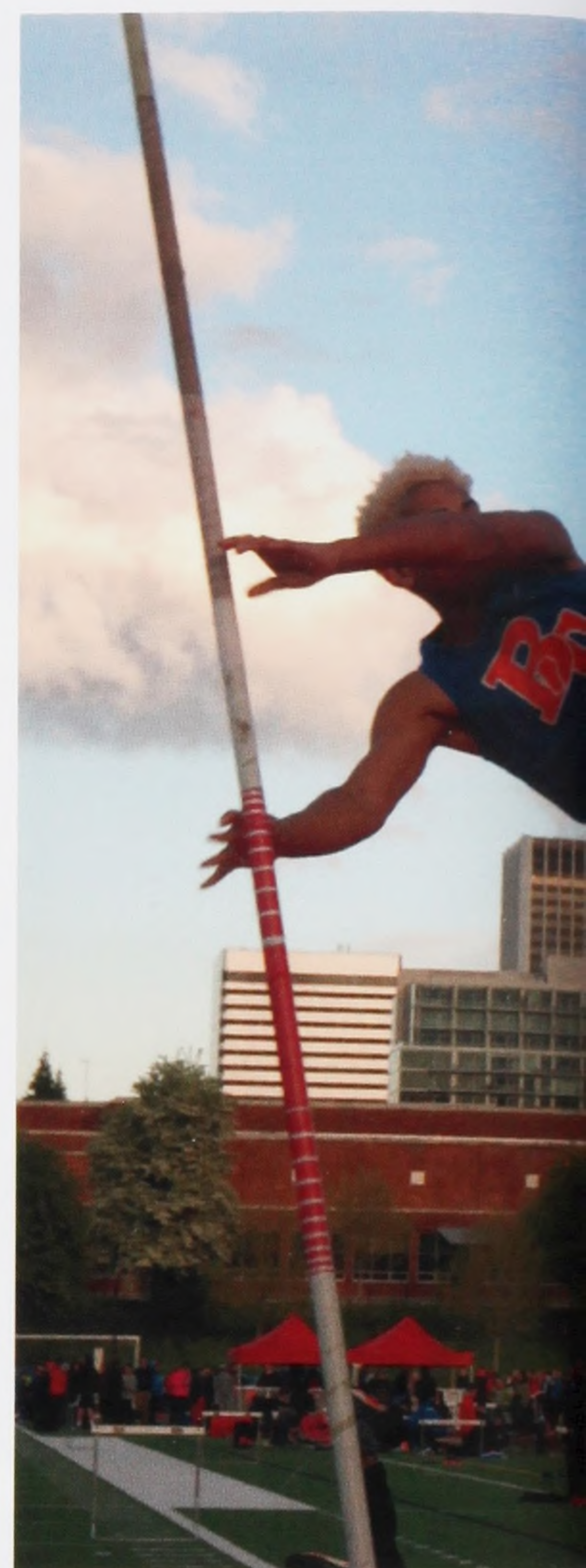
Why do tennis players not date each other?

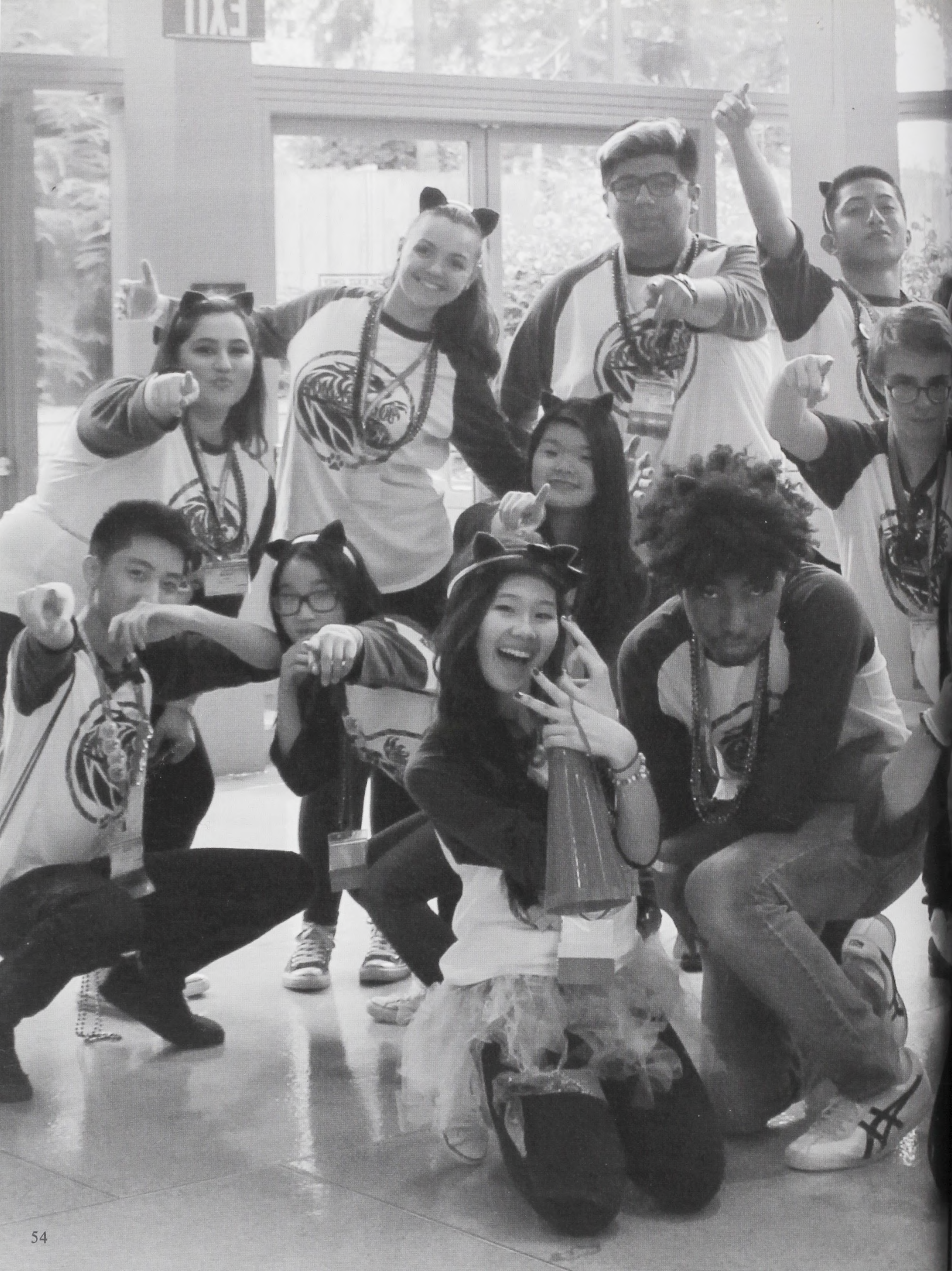

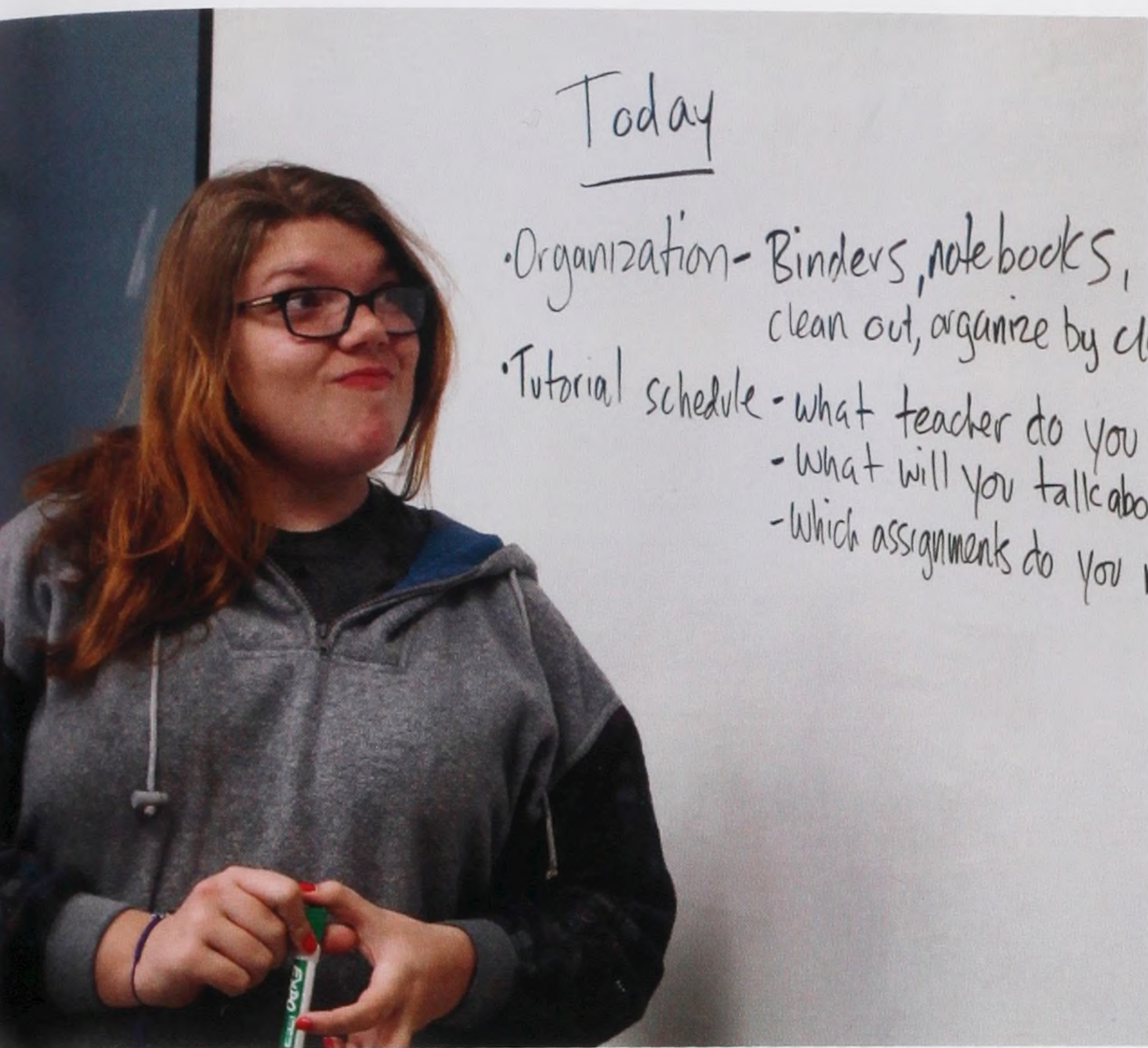

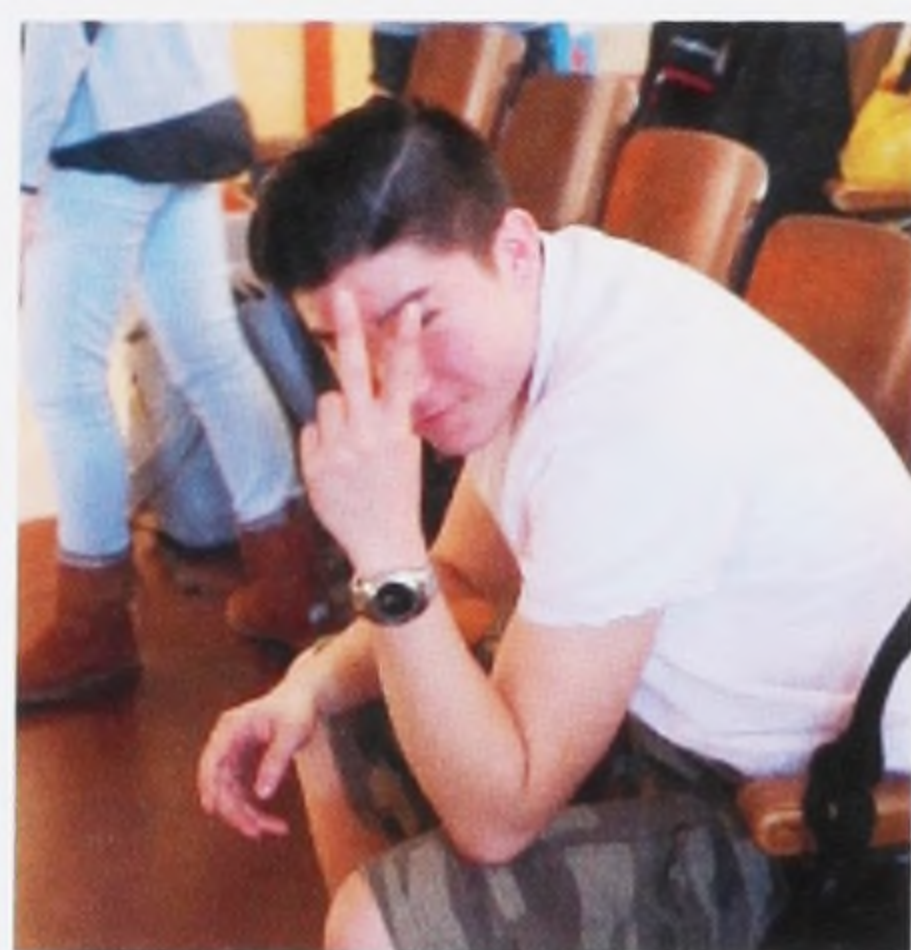


Science Bowl is a competition held annually for teams who train to compete in their knowledge of sciences and math.
