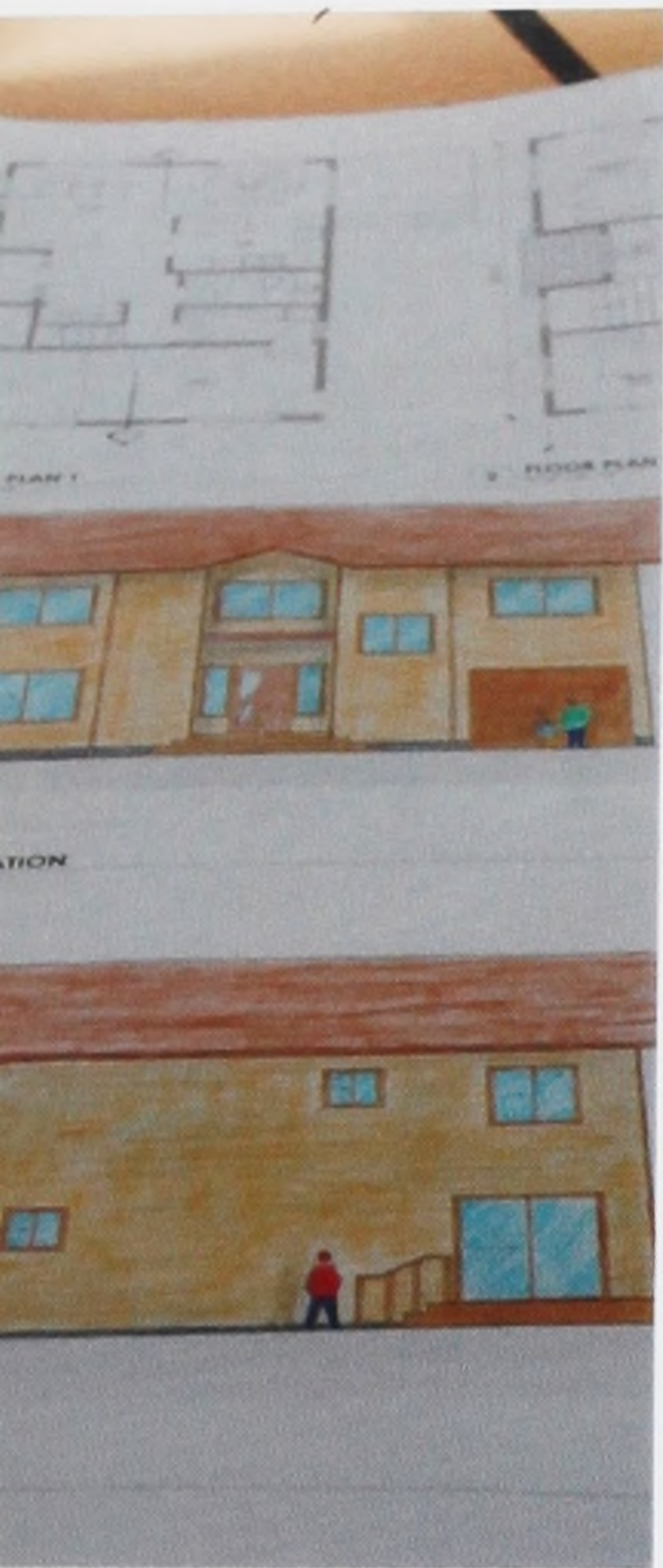

Crafting the Floorplan of Success

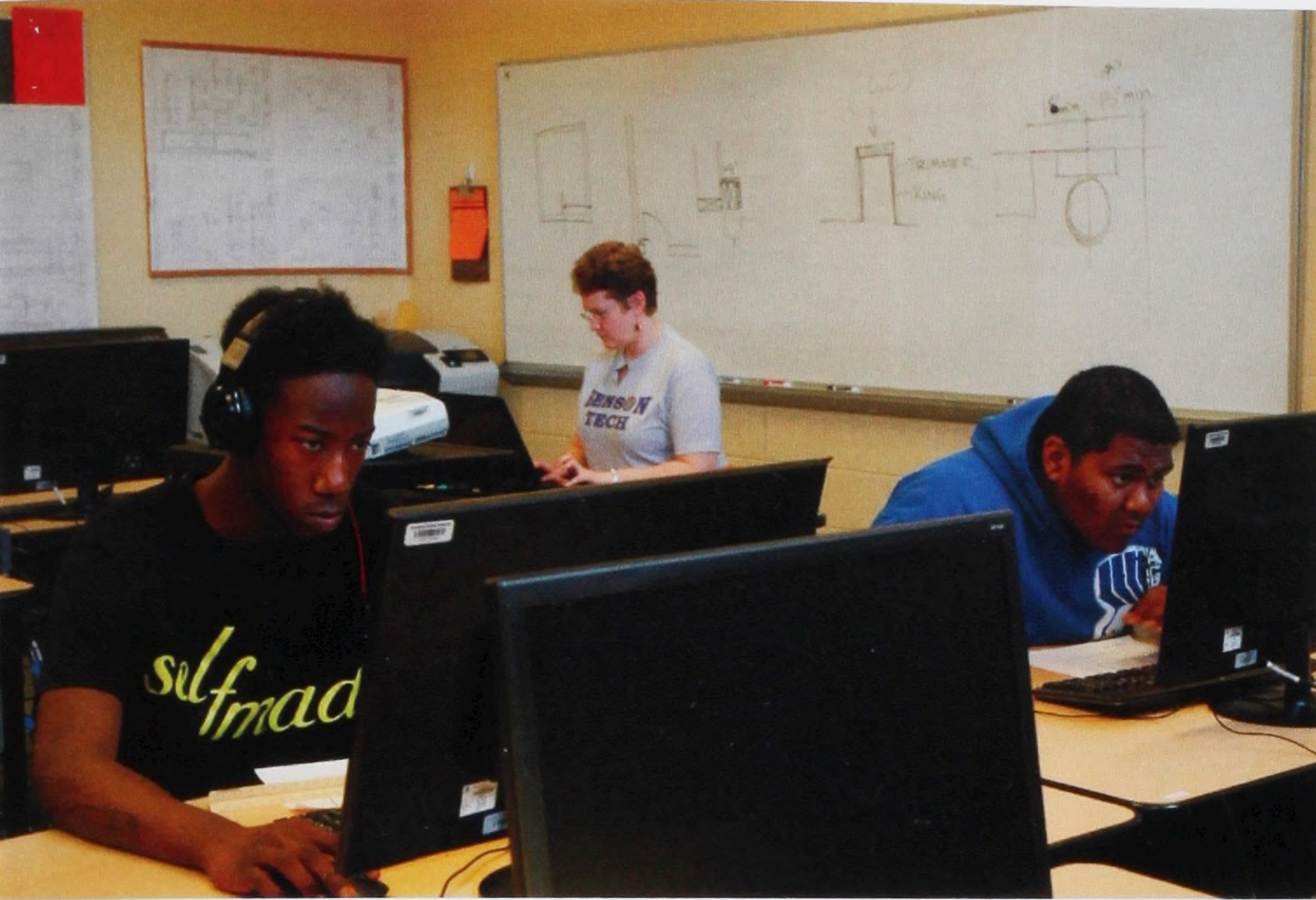


Seen above is the senior drafting crew. The small class size allows the students to work closely together on projects such as the Benson House.

Sometimes going through "archi-torture", as Ms. Hite puts it, results in a grand finished project. Students are free to create their own unique designs, this year ranging from community centers to Norwegian restaurants.

The use of AutoCAD allows the students to graphically represent their ideas in a professional manner so they are ready to jump into their career. Drafting students get to meet with mentors from PSU and work alongside the architects in the Master Planning Committee for the rebuilding of Benson.

The seniors gain great connections through these networking opportunities and develop a sense of what the industry is really like.



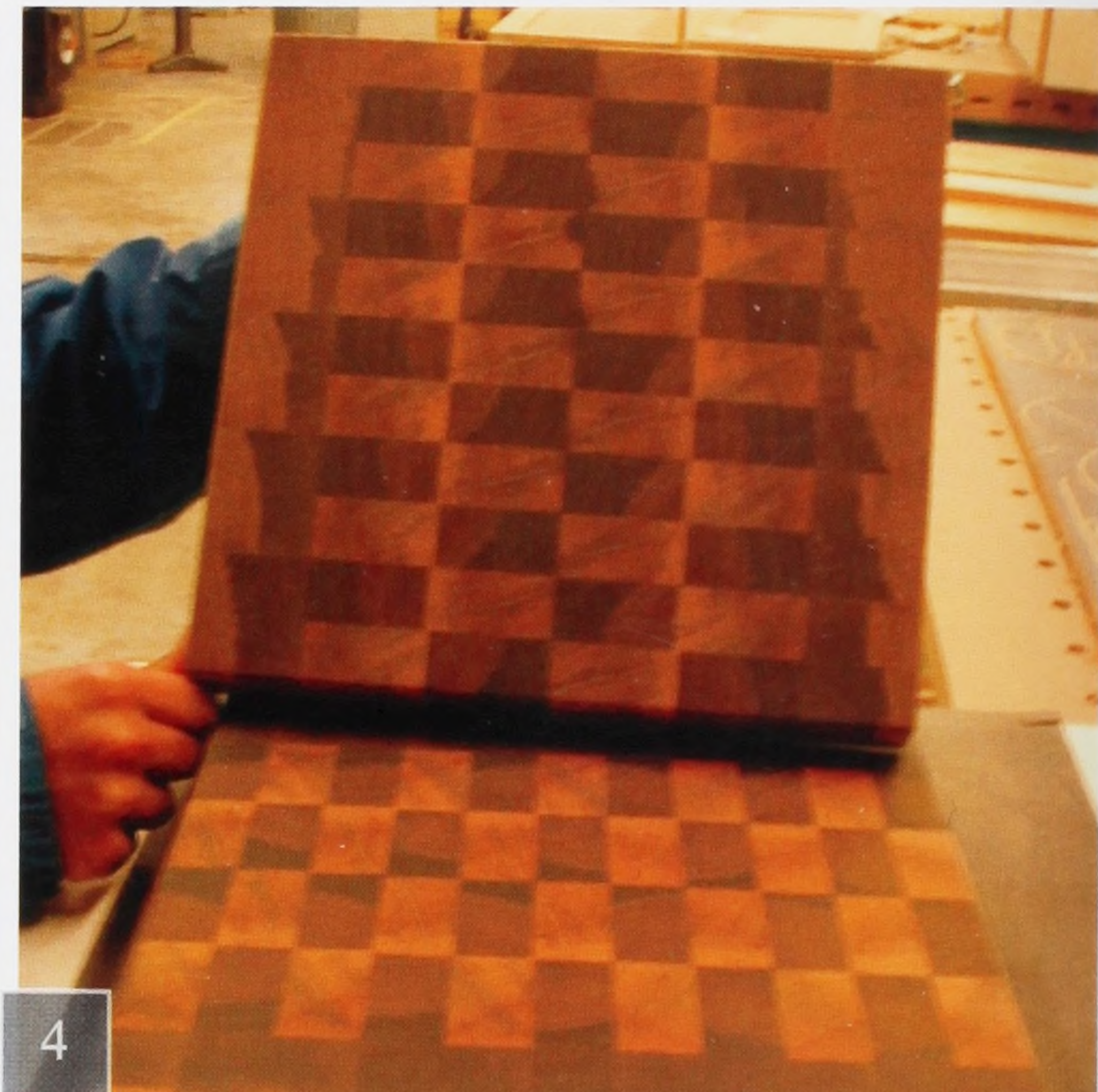
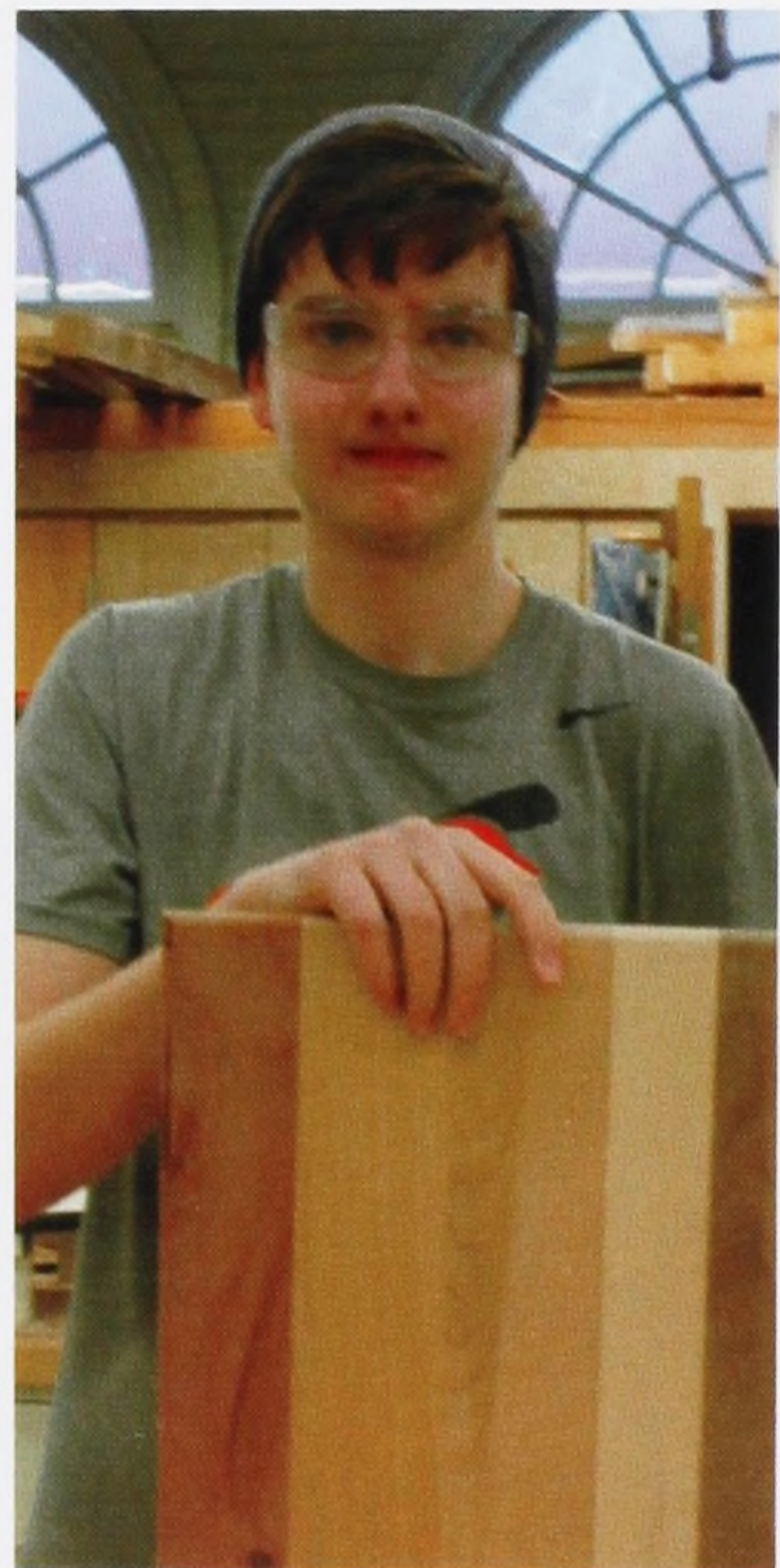
Architecture teacher Ms. Hite describes going through freshman year as gaining the foundations of the industry's work. Their curriculum begins with using pencils on drawing boards, learning how to measure accurately and know differing line types.

Sophomores start on computers and design projects where they get used to programs such as AutoCAD. With the increasing integration of technology in architecture design, the use of AutoCAD allows them to get accustomed to the same materials they'd find in a real firm.

When asking the classes what their favorite projects were, a frequent answer was working on the yearly Benson House floorplans. Also, being a smaller class, there is a more communal feeling when they do projects. In addition to their favorite projects, they tackled the remodeling of Benson.

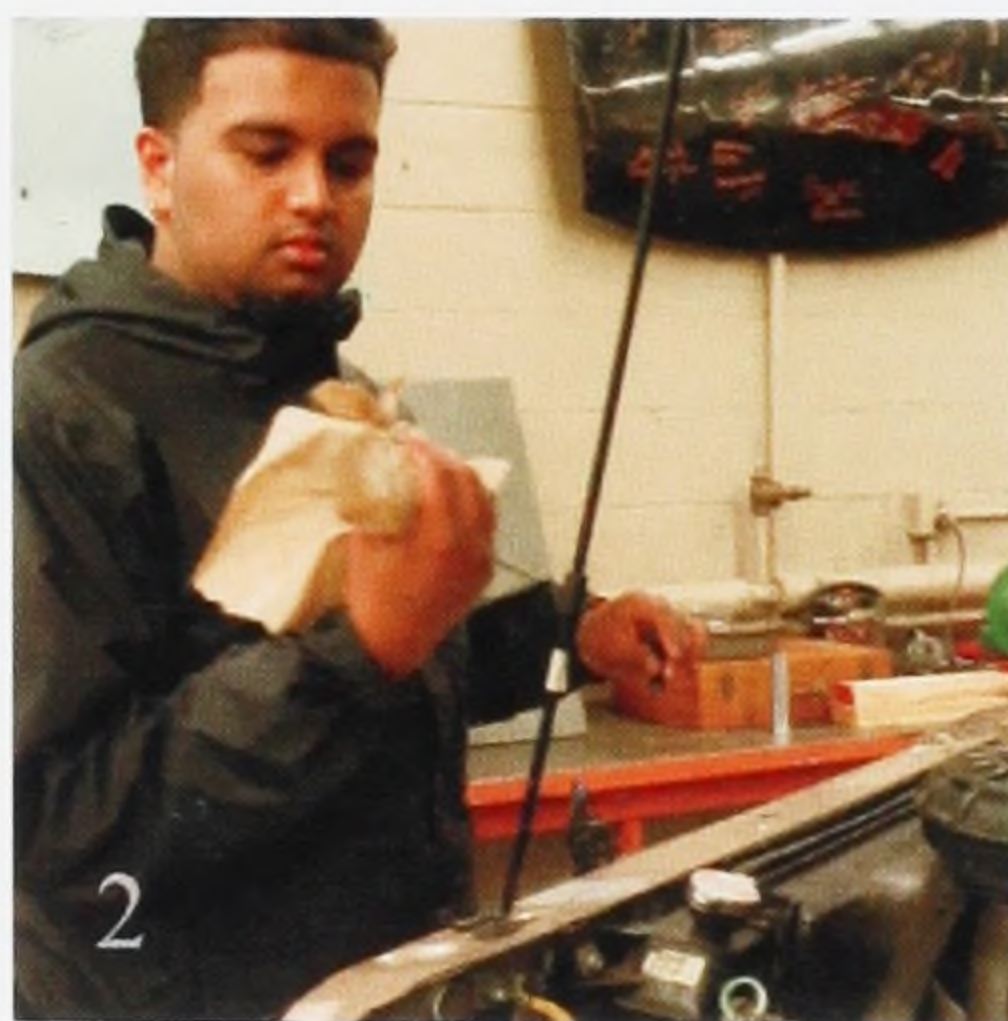


The freedom that comes with the class allows the students to do personal projects. Once they master AutoCAD and the basics of the tools, the world is their oyster.

AUTOMOTIVE

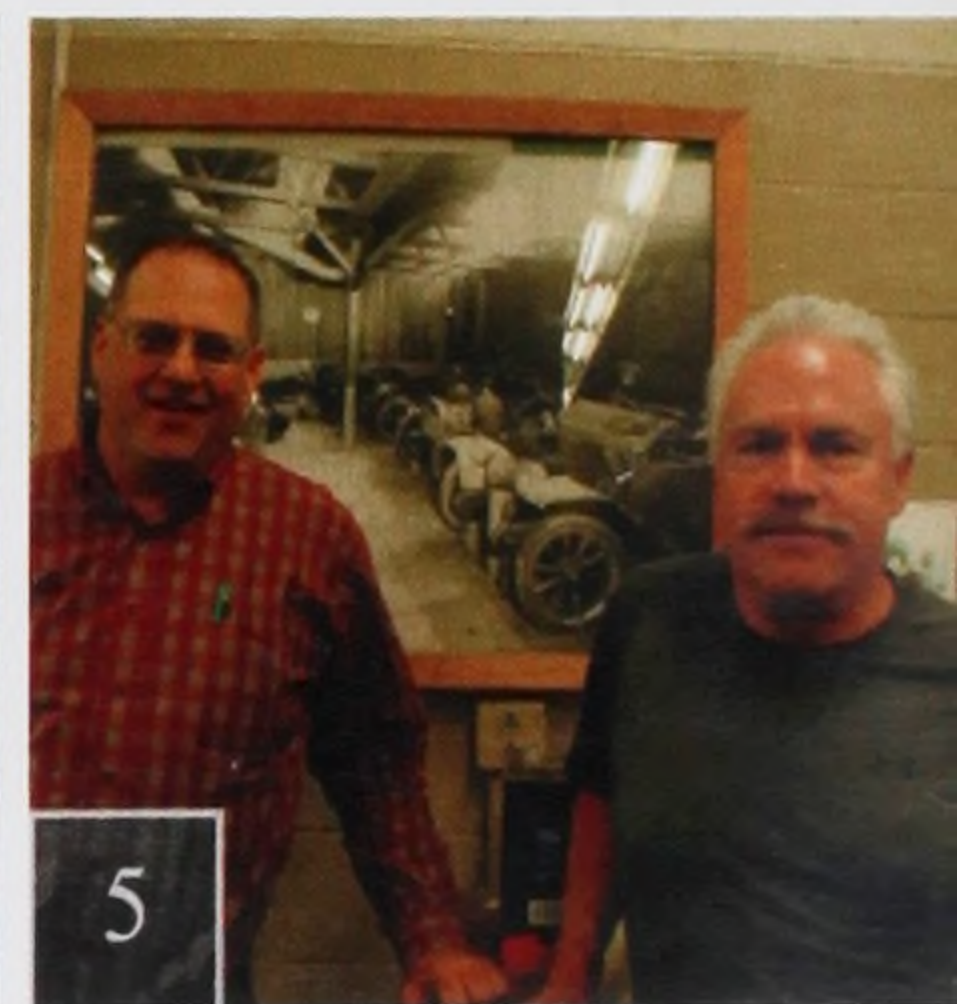
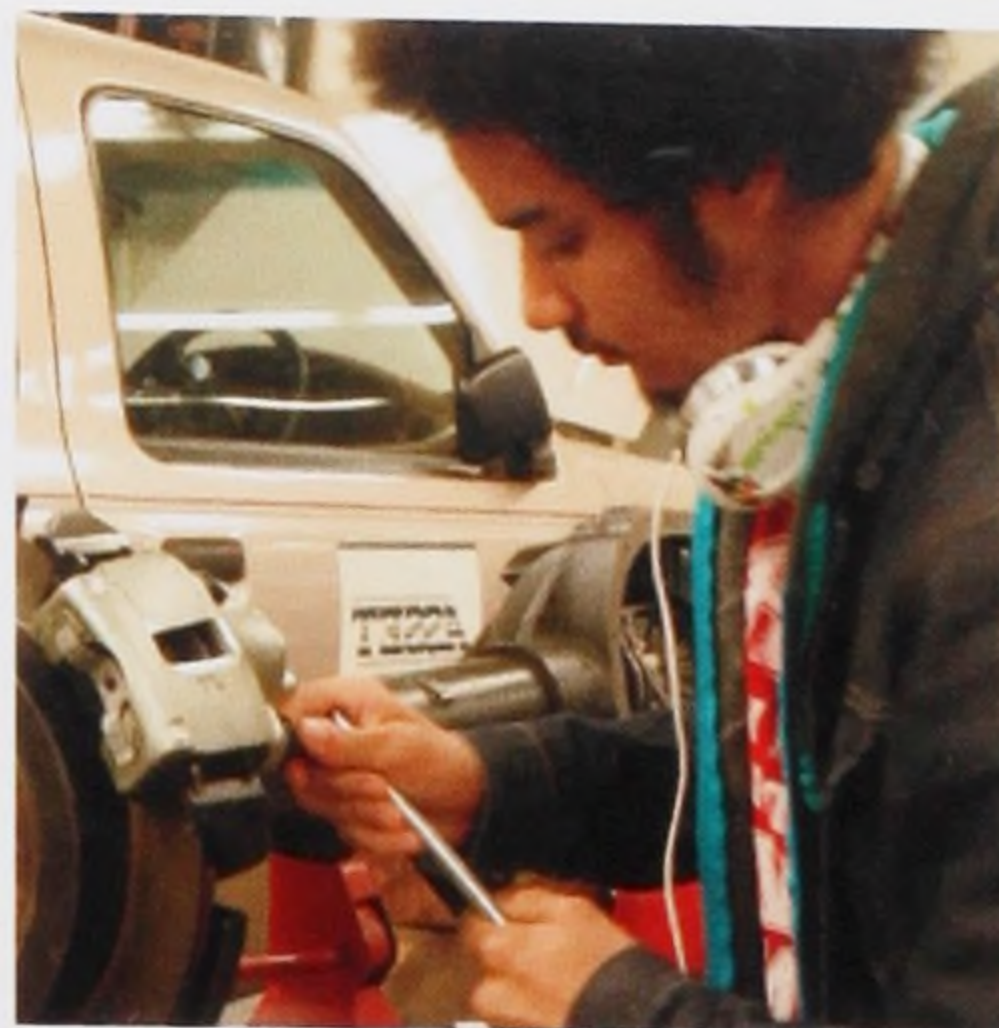

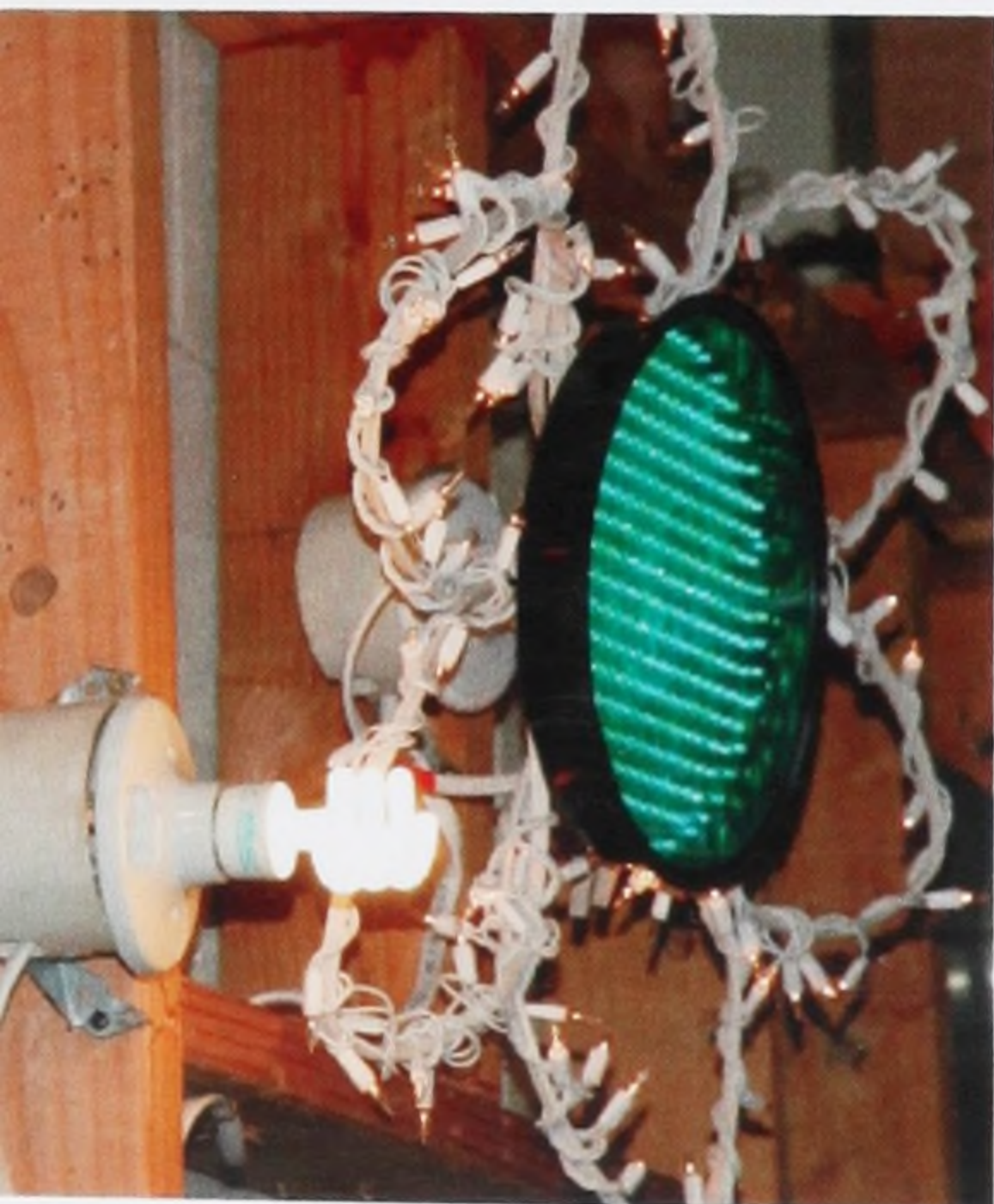
4. Half of your senior year you get to learn all about aviation. This is Benson's very own helicopter which, as well as our other aviation vehicles, still works.

THE WOMEN OF ELECTRIC

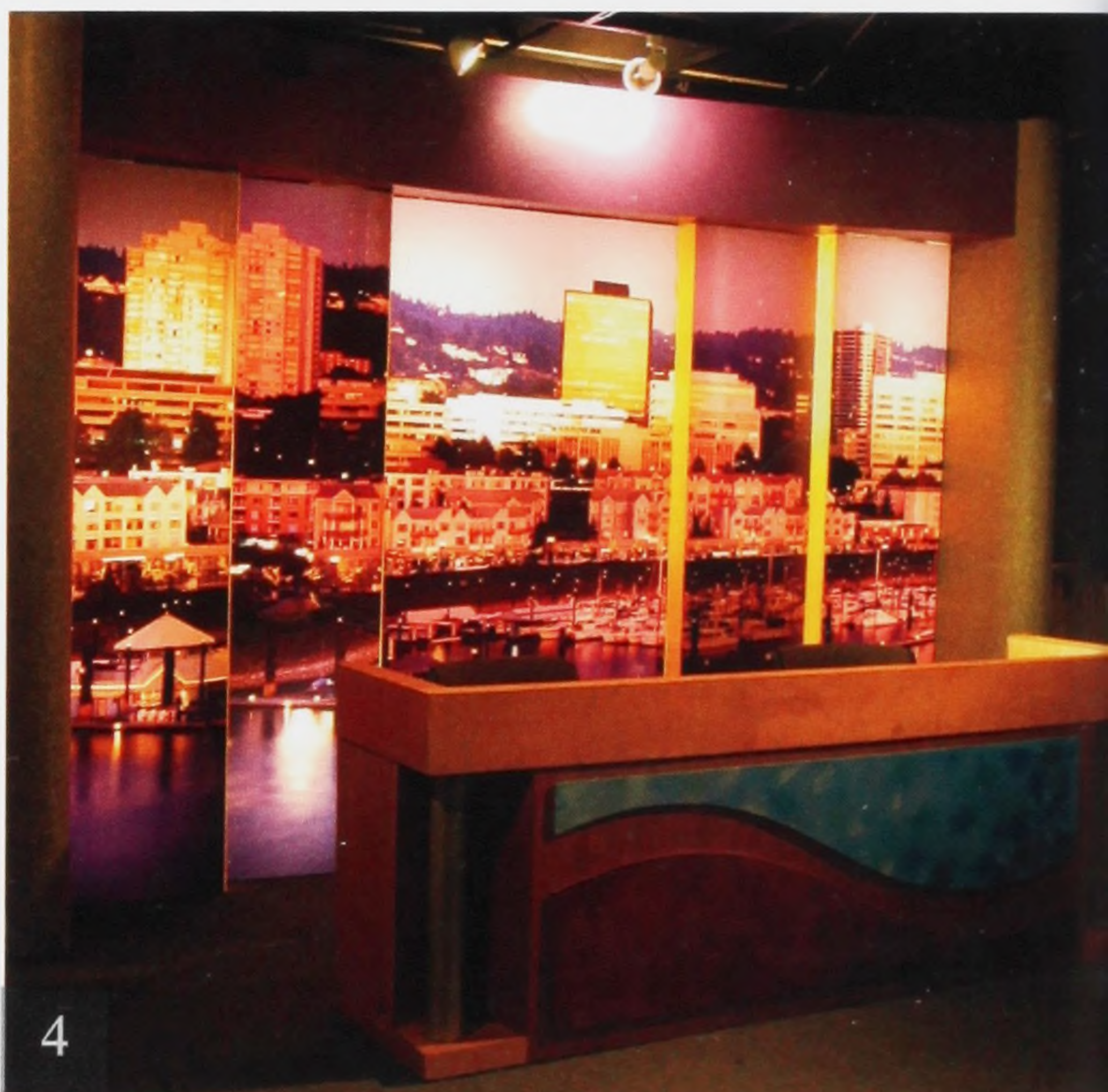

KBPS 1450 AM

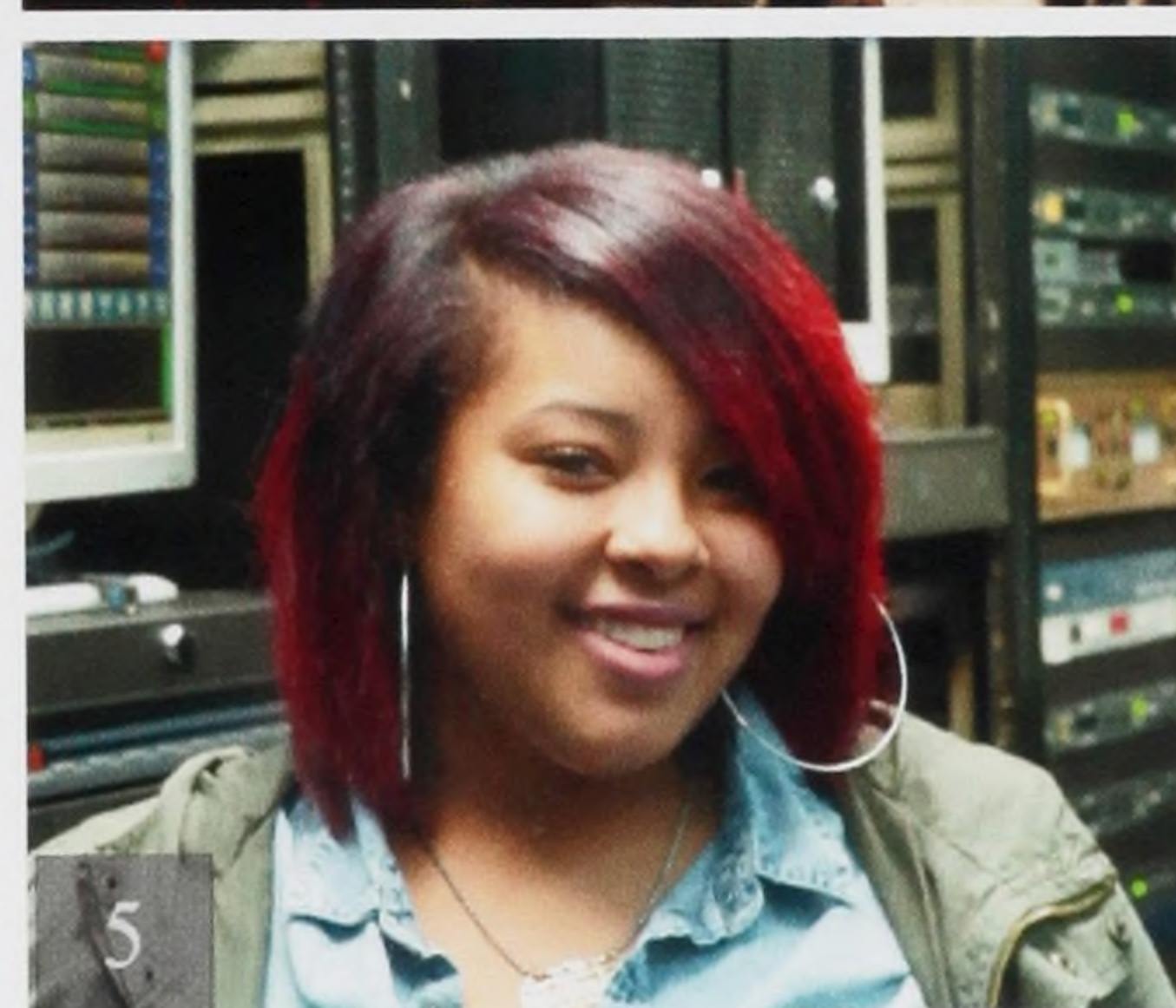


1. KBPS is one of the oldest stations in Portland, starting in early May of 1923, and officially changed its call letters from KFIF to KBPS in 1930.

-I chose Radio because I wanted to be closer to music. I thought it was really cool that we had our own radio station and that we get to talk on air, and it was something outside of my comfort zone.

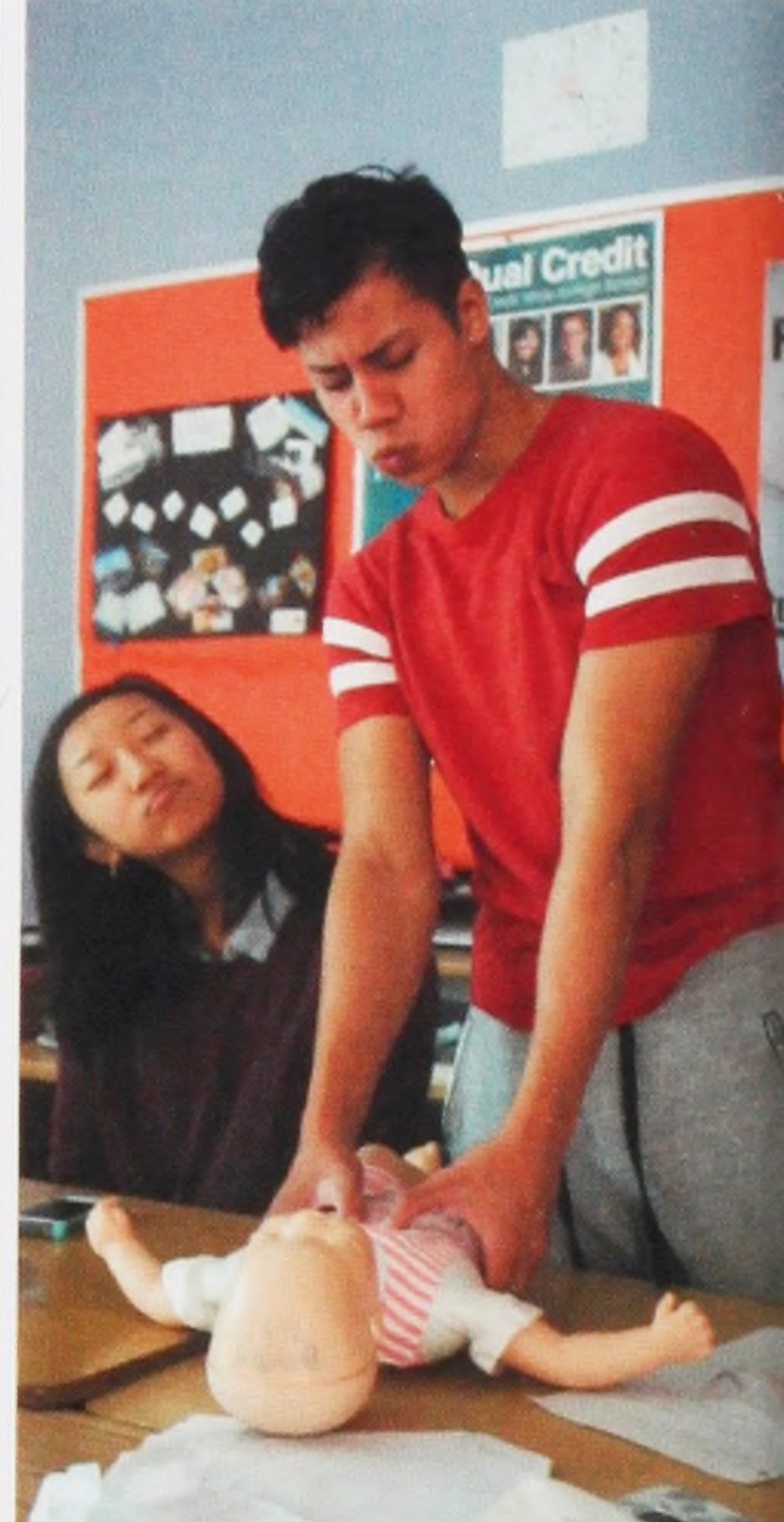
What skills have you developed from being in Radio and what career do you see yourself in after high school?

HEALTH OCC. Time to Save Some Lives!



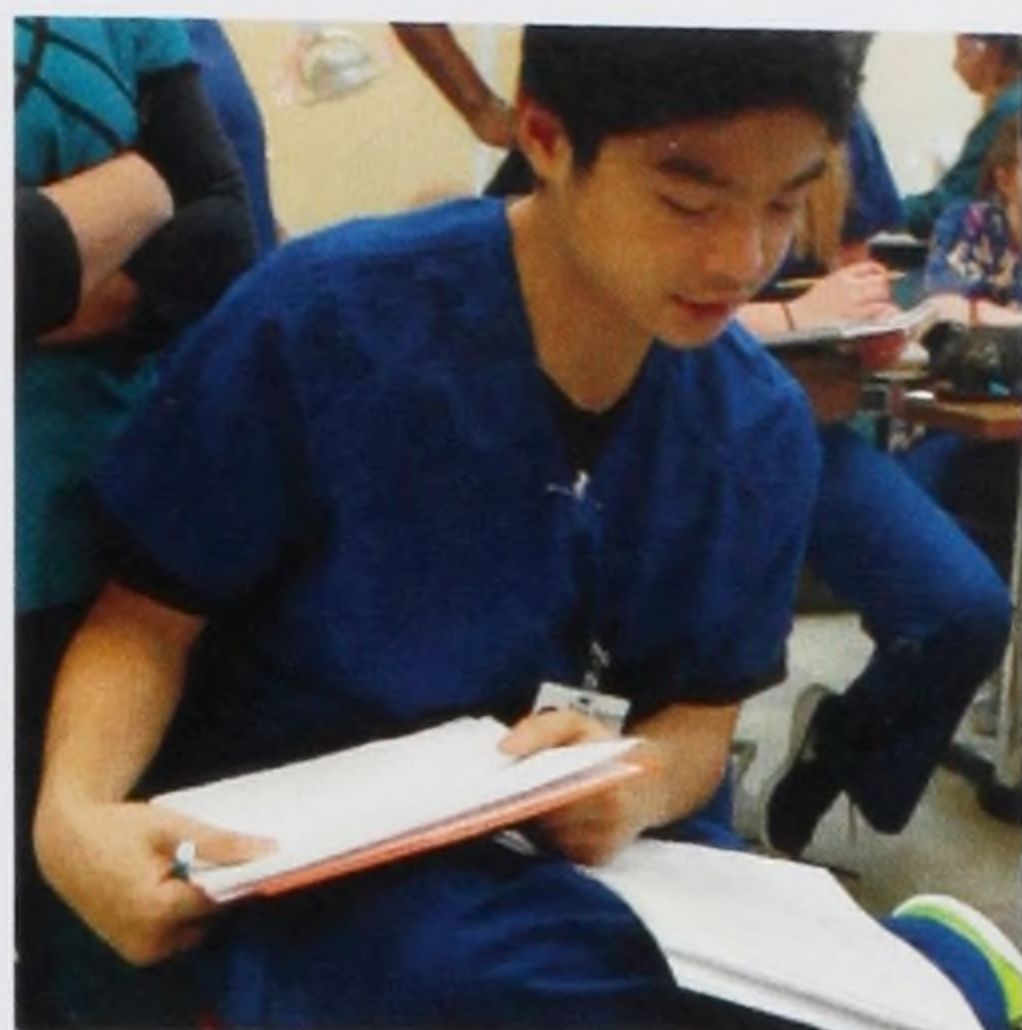

Math can get really confusing really quick! That's why you have to stay focused like Teresa Tran and Janie Nguyen.



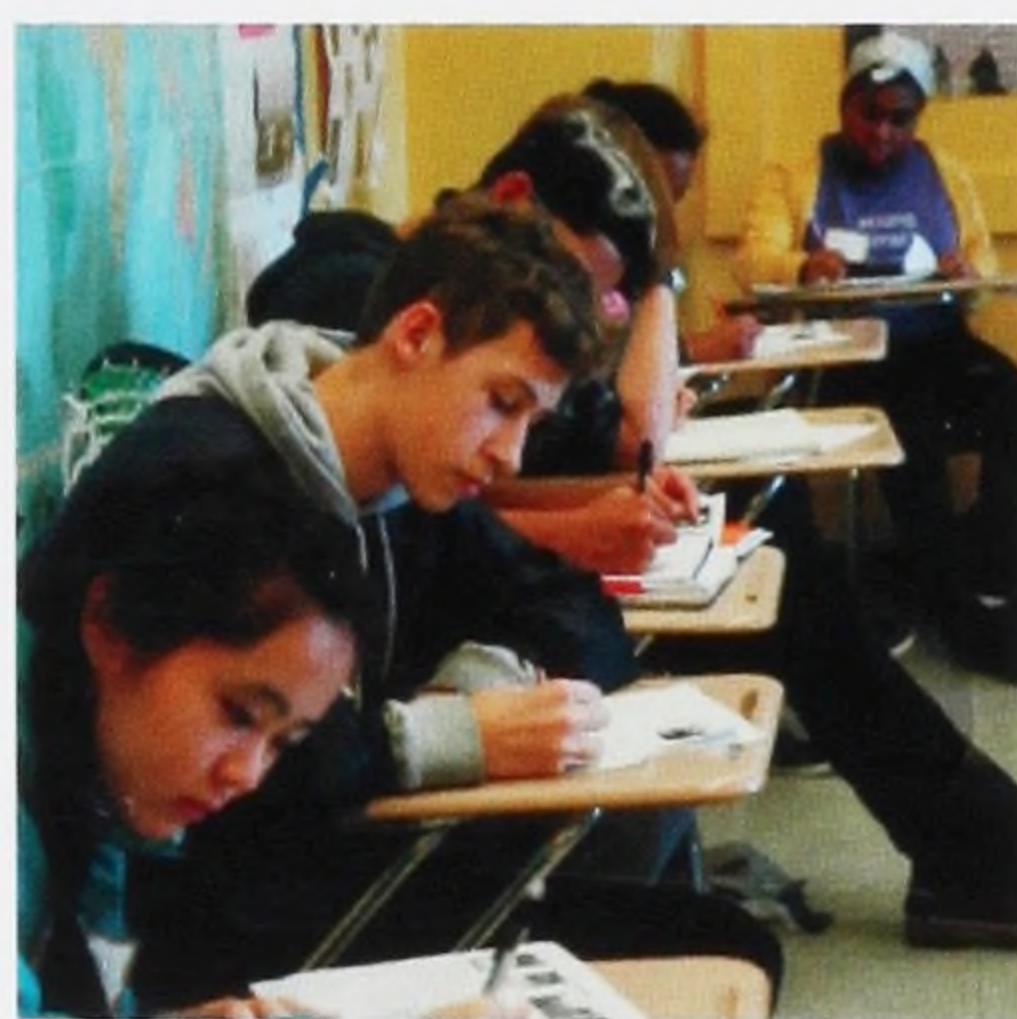
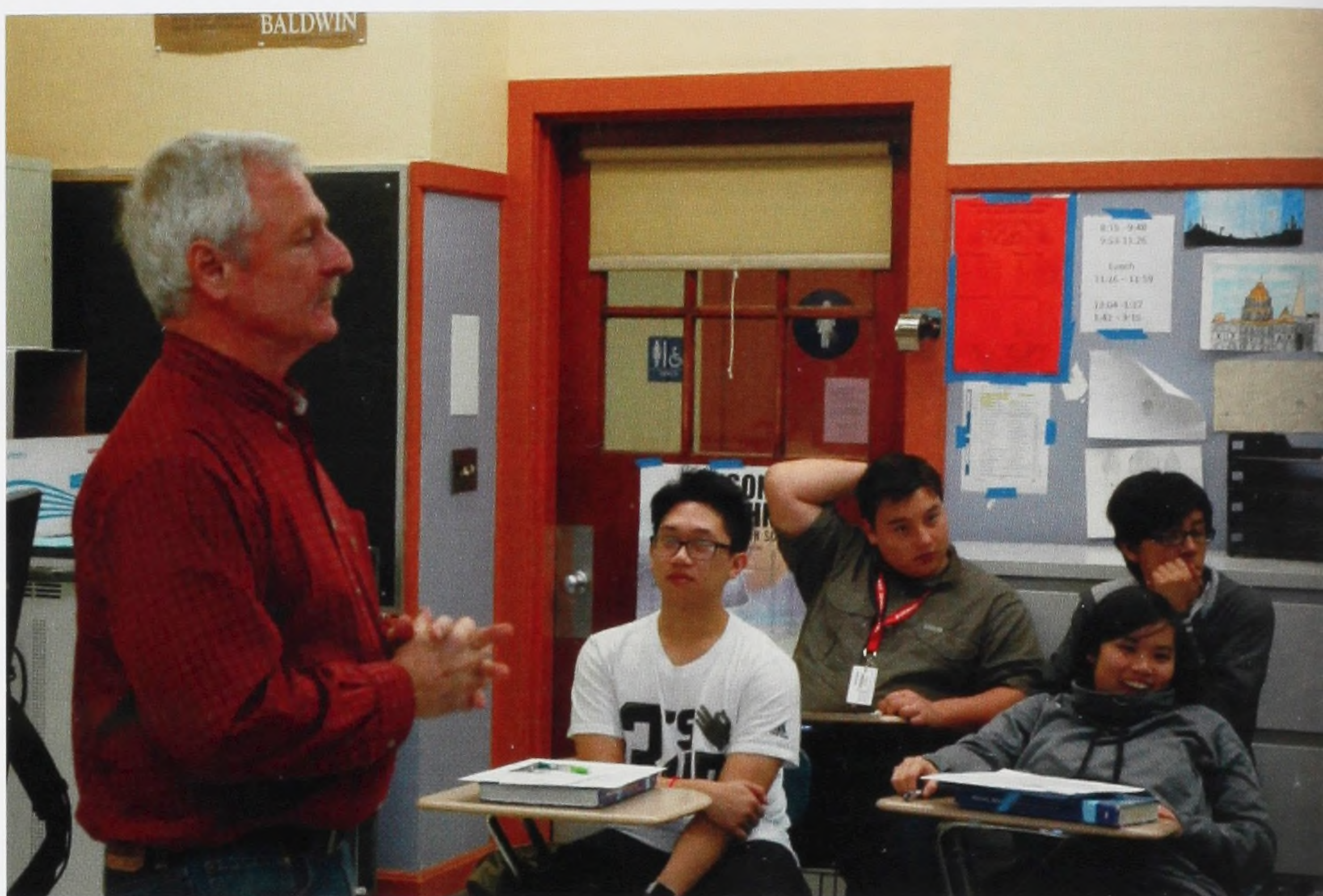

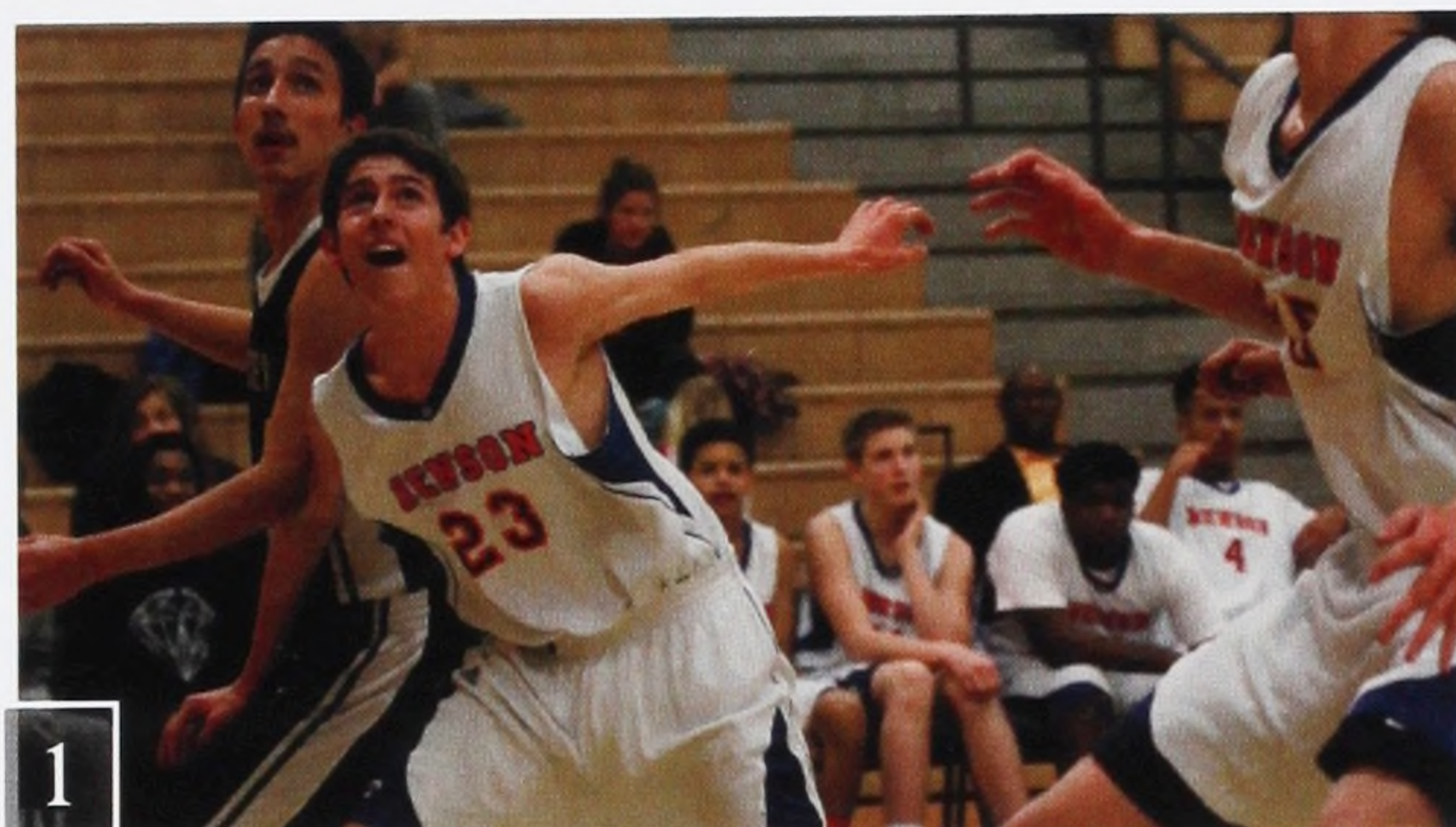

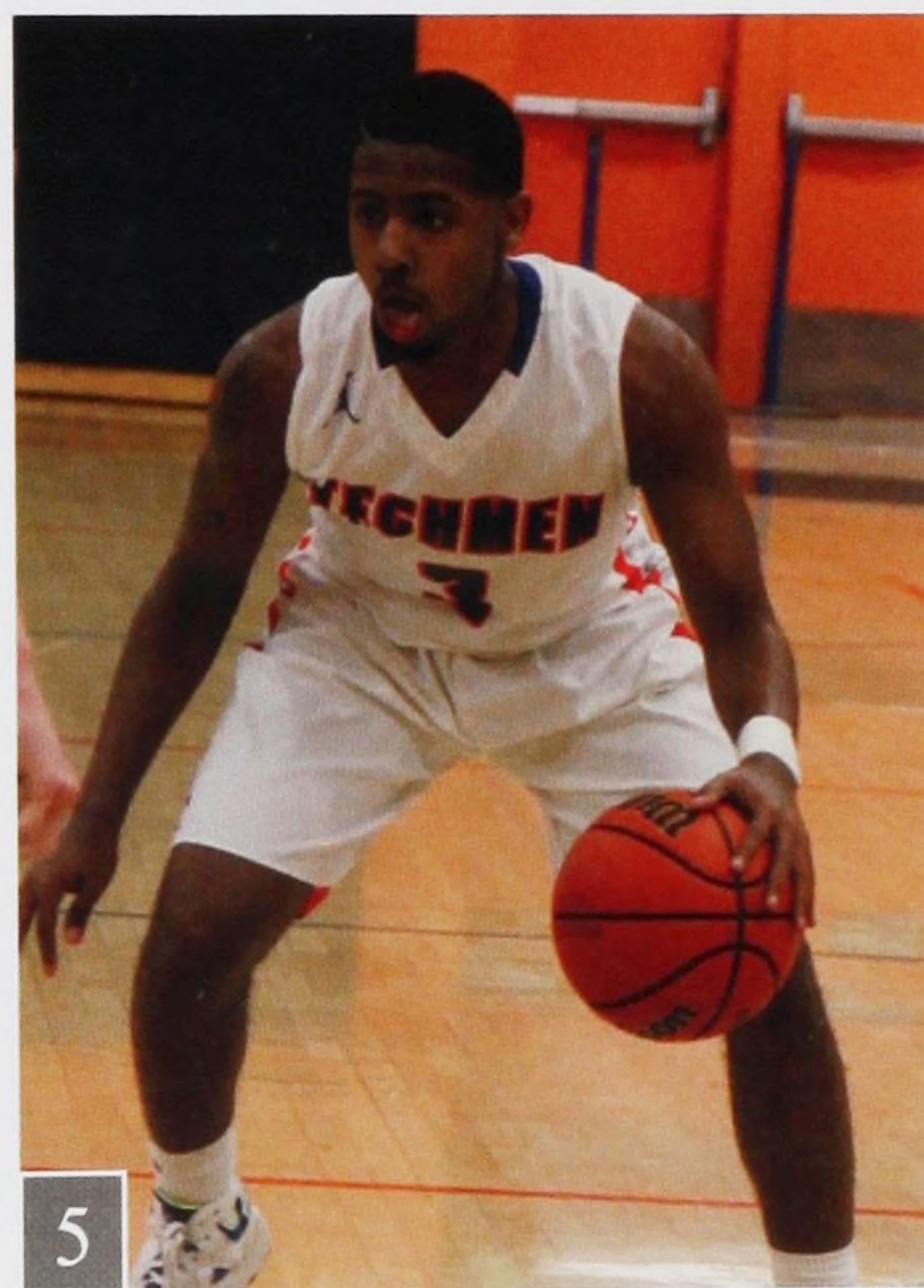

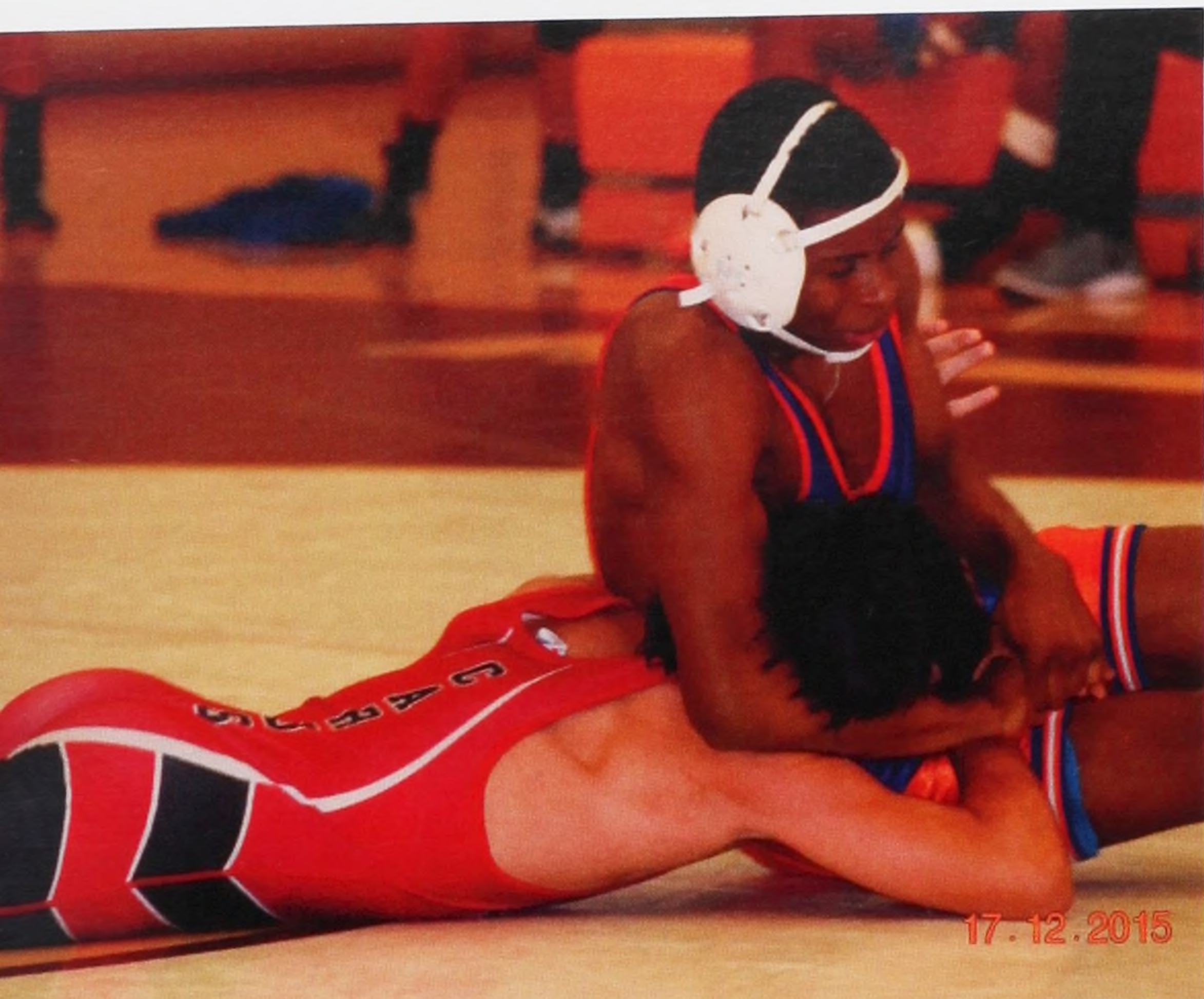

4. Abdi Hussein battles Lincoln and Grant runners on the 1600 meter relay. He gave the team a strong lead and is striving to finish his lap strong.



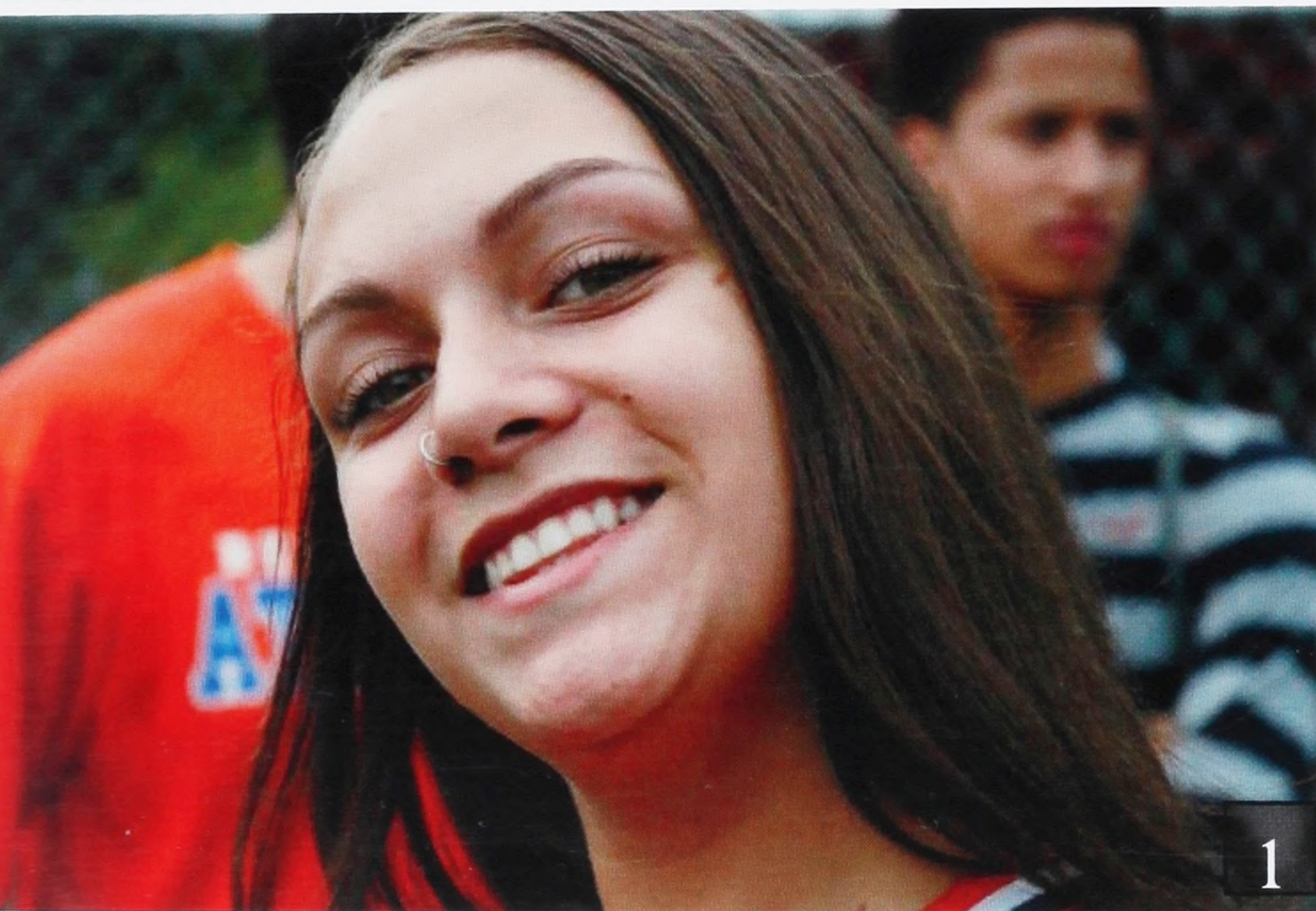

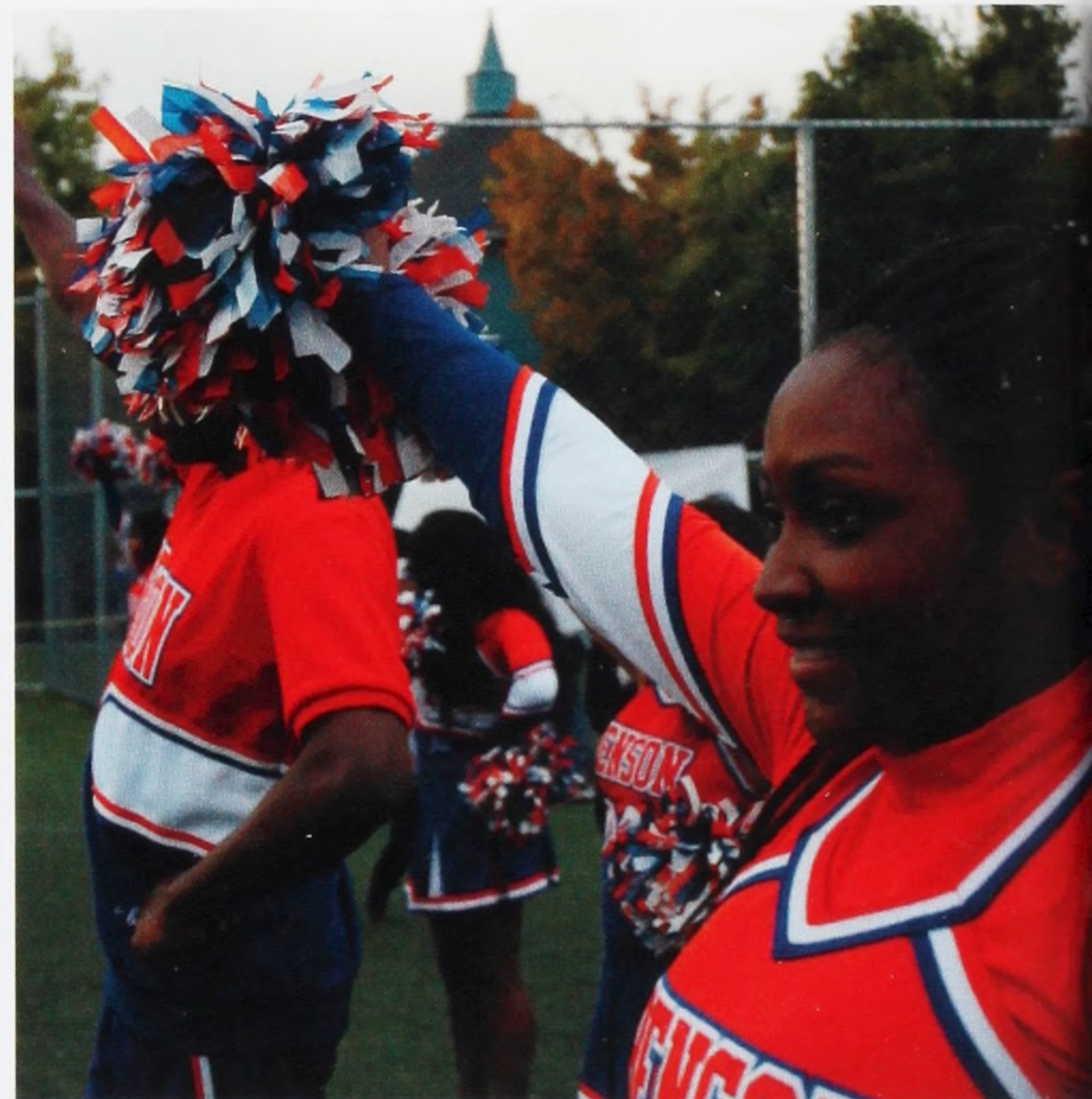
8. Kalani Brumbaugh prepares to throw a javelin. She is a varsity thrower and captain for the track team. She also teaches new recruits how to throw javelin.

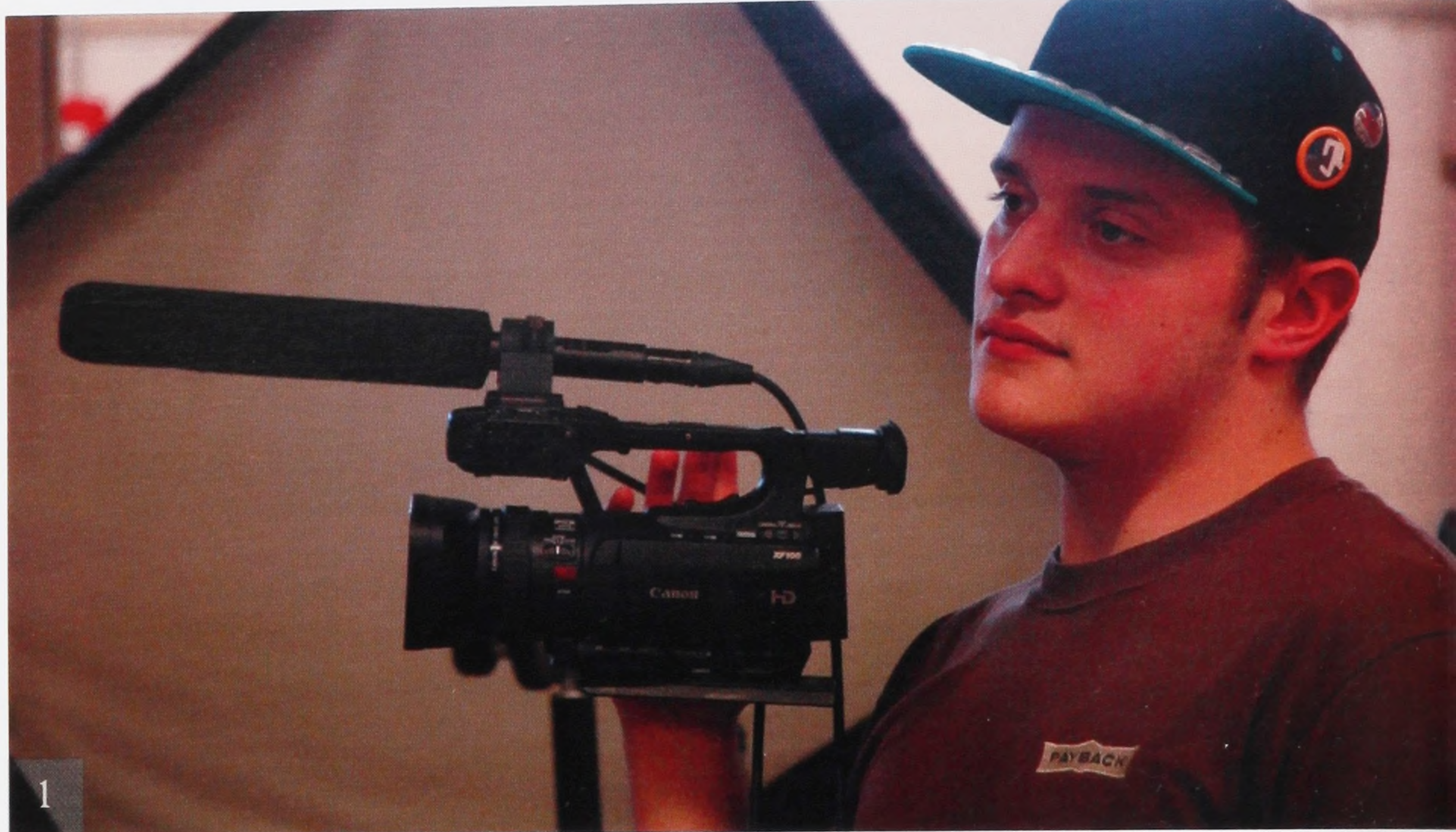

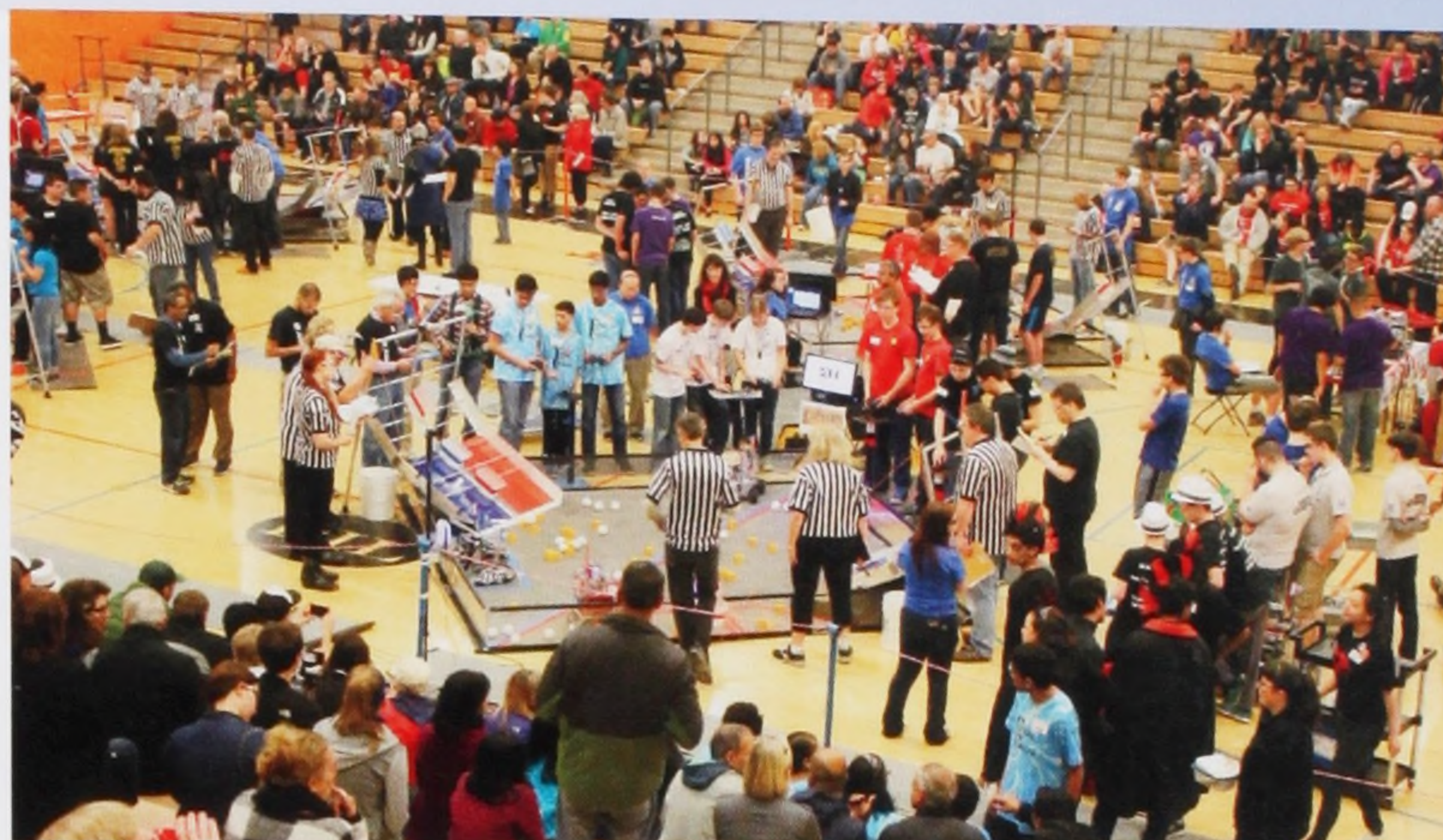
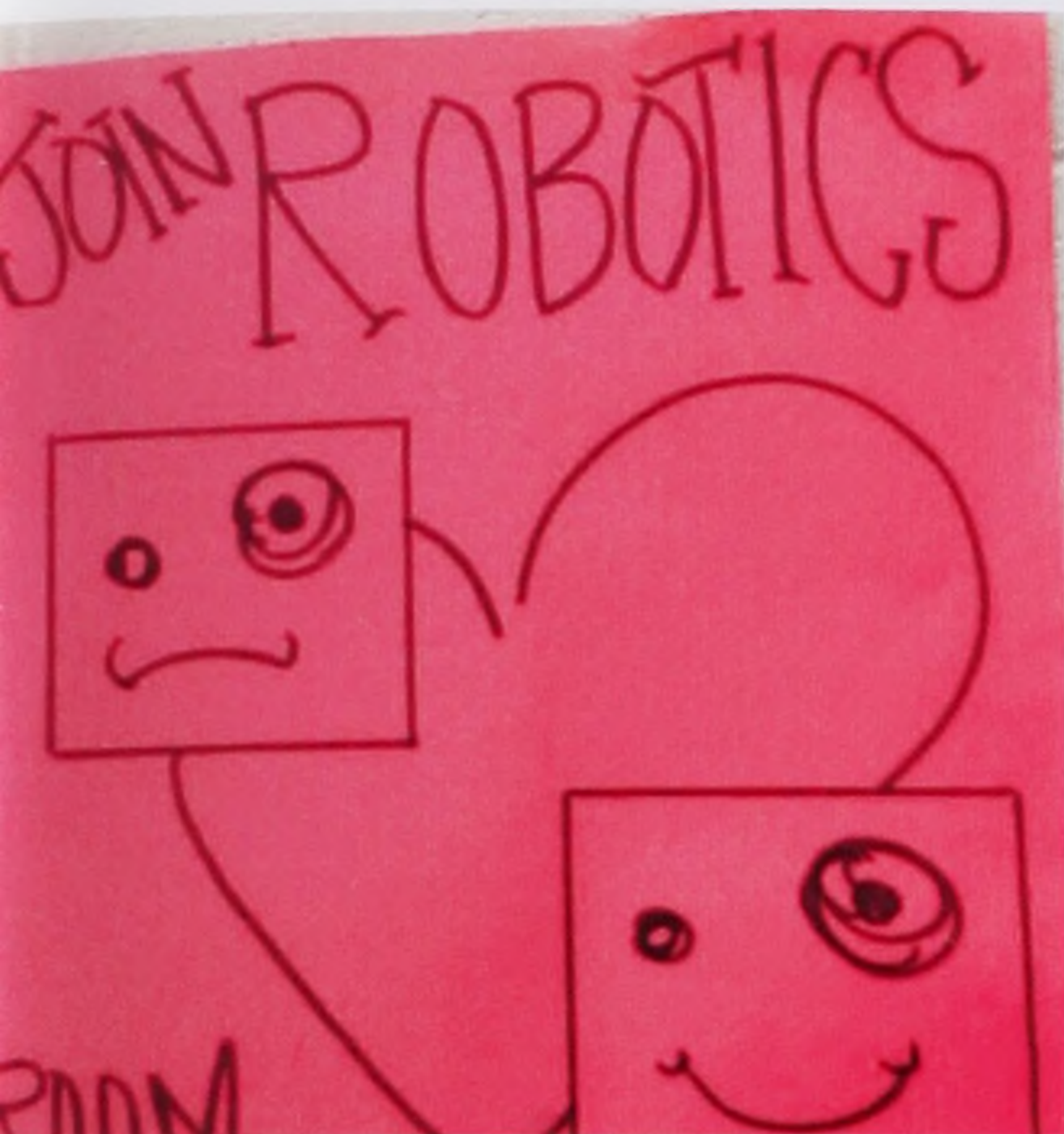
1. Wyatt Gilderson stands by waiting to shoot a story. Not only do Tech News students have to find and film the stories, they also get to edit the video and sound.

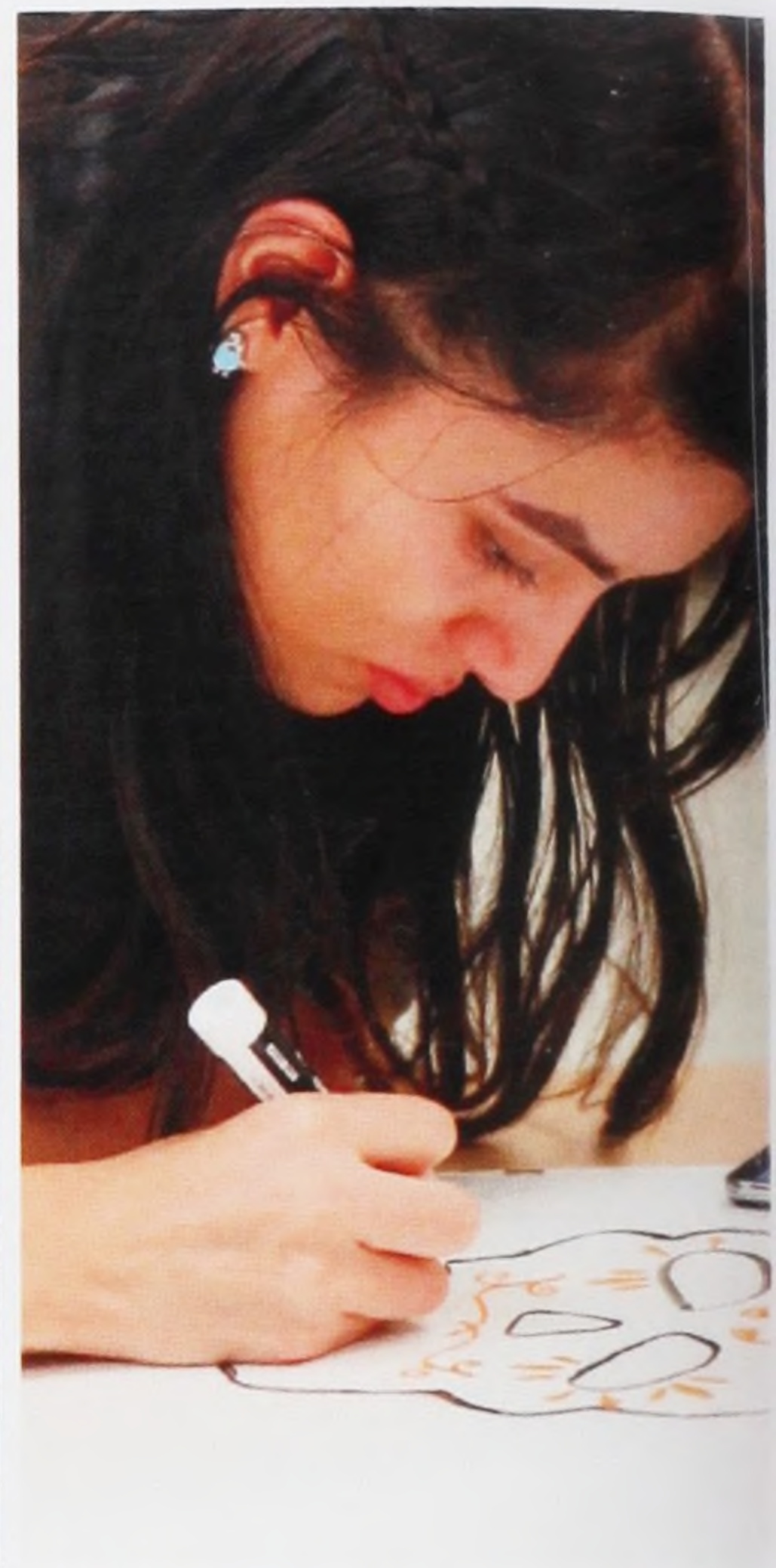

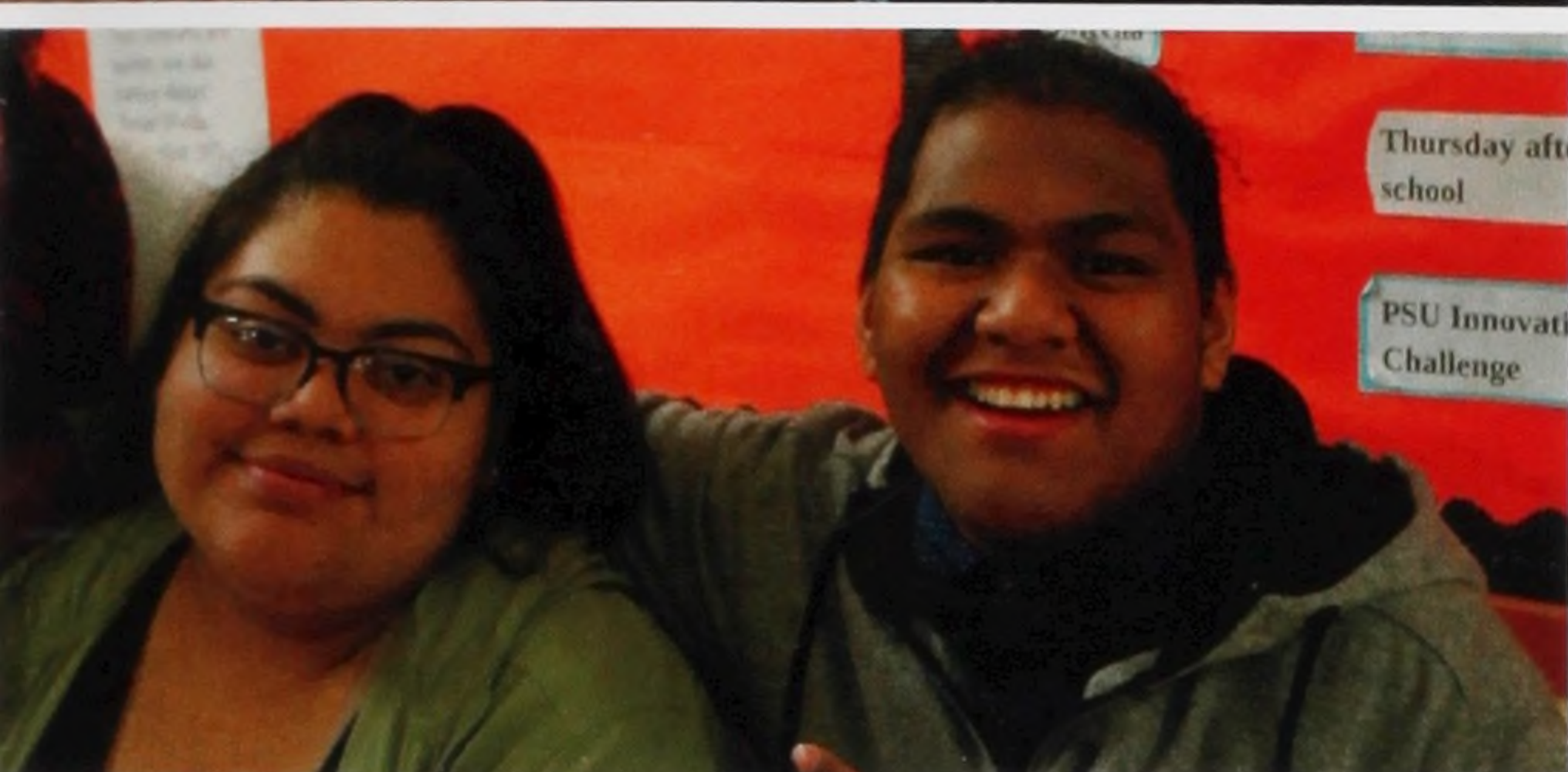
The Tradition Continues
